ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION In Compliance with Chapter 617, F.S., (Not for Profit)

Article I – Name of the Corporation

The name of the corporation shall be: Libertas Scholars, Inc.

The purpose for which the organization is organized is to provide educational programs and resources for children. Upon dissolution or winding up of the corporation, its assets remaining after payment, or provision for payment of all debts and liabilities shall be distributed for one or more exempt

purposes within the meaning of section 501 (c)(3) of the Code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose.
