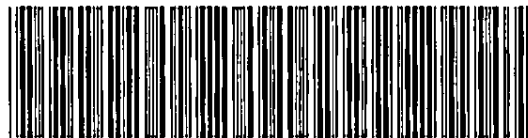

ARTICLE III- PURPOSE

1) Lighting the Darkness, Inc. is a nonprofit organization that is committed to addressing the needs of disadvantaged people, regardless of their religion, race, sex, or nationality. Our goal is to transform the lives of the people we work with helping them to break the cycles of poverty. We will accomplish this by identifying their specific needs and working to address those needs in both the short and long term. Through our organization's programs and services, we hope to help each individual that we work with find their unique talents and gifts and use those skills to improve their own life and walk with a purpose.

2) No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall consist of carrying on of propaganda or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in, any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office.

3) The Corporation is organized exclusively for charitable, religious, educational and scientific purposes, including for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as an exempt organization under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

ARTICLE IX - DISSOLUTION

1) The property of this corporation is irrevocably dedicated to charitable purposes and no part of the net income or assets of this corporation shall ever inure to the benefit of any director, officer or member thereof or to the benefit of any private person.

2) The manner of distribution of assets in this Corporation's winding up is as follows:

Upon dissolution of the Corporation, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or state or local government for public purpose. Any such asset not so disposed of shall be disposed of by the Court of Competent Jurisdiction of the county in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purpose or to such organization or organizations as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.
