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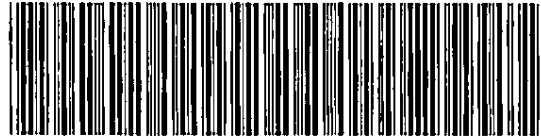

ARTICLE III PURPOSE

The purpose for which the corporation is organized is:

Team Momentum Inc. is organized for the purpose of empowering and equipping today's youth to become the leaders of their generation. **Team Momentum Inc.** endeavors to provide mentoring services to empower young men to become innovative and integrative leaders in their local and global communities.

Team Momentum Inc. is organized exclusively for charitable purposes to include mentoring young people, providing scholarships, and the making of contributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under the section 501(c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section on any future federal tax code.

No part of the net earnings of Momentum X shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the organization shall be authorized to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purpose set forth in the purpose set forth in the purpose clause hereof. No substantial part of the activities of the organization shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the organization shall not participate in or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provisions of this document, the organization shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carrying on (a) by an organization exempt from federal income tax under section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding sections of a future federal tax code, or (b) by an organization, contributions to which are deductible under section 170 (c) (2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

Upon the dissolution of Team Momentum Inc.'s assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501 (c) (3) if the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government or to a state or local government, for public purpose. Any such assets not disposed of shall be disposed of by the Court of Common Pleas of the county of the county of which the principal office of the organization is then located exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organization, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.


