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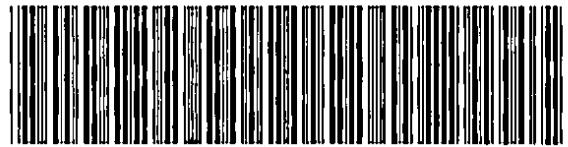

Article I Name

The name of the corporation shall be A Royal Priesthood Ministries, Inc.
