

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF SARASOTA EAGLES SOCCER ACADEMY CORPORATION

(A Corporation Not for Profit)

In order to form a corporation under and in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 617, Florida Statutes, I hereby make, adopt, and subscribe the following Articles of Incorporation:

I. NAME OF CORPORATION

The name of this corporation shall be:

Sarasota Eagles Soccer Academy Corporation



II. PURPOSES

The purposes for which the corporation is organized are exclusively charitable and educational within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law. The corporation is organized and shall be operated exclusively as a charitable organization to combat juvenile delinquency and to promote social and community welfare as allowed by Chapter 617, Florida Statutes, and Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, including for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

The general nature, objects and purposes of the corporation shall be to operate without profit and to accept and receive property of whatever kind, and wherever situate, received by it by gift, grant, purchase, devise, bequest, or in any lawful manner and to administer and distribute such property exclusively for charitable and educational purposes, including:




- To distribute property in accordance with the terms of gifts, bequests, or devises made to the corporation which are not inconsistent with its purposes;
- B. To modify any restriction or condition on the administration and distribution of funds for any specified purpose consistent herewith it in the sole judgment of the board of directors, such restriction or condition becomes, in effect, unnecessary, incapable of fulfillment, or inconsistent with the designated purposes of the corporation.

The specific nature, objects, and purposes of the corporation are using sports, specifically soccer: (i) to foster the holistic development of children, using the sport of soccer as a teaching environment; (ii) to teach children the sport of soccer, including its physical, technical, tactical, and psycho-social components, using evidence-based methods of teaching and coaching; (iii) to foster the participation of children in high level amateur youth soccer competition; and (iv) to foster the future participation of children in amateur collegiate soccer competition.

In furtherance of the specific nature, objects, and purposes of the corporation, the following programs will be offered:

- A. The Board of Directors and the staff of the corporation will serve the purpose of the corporation on a voluntary basis.
- B. The corporation will affiliate with US Club Soccer, and/or any other youth soccer organization, that is affiliated with the United States Soccer Federation, the national governing body of soccer in the United States.
- C. The corporation will abide by all bylaws and rules of the United States Soccer Federation.
- O. The corporation will participate in soccer competition organized by the United States Soccer Pederation and/or its affiliate youth soccer organizations.
- E. The corporation will abide by the rules of the Sarasota County Government, or any other entity the corporation enters into agreement for facility use.
- F. The corporation will aim to make participation affordable, or free of charge for all participants by obtaining charitable donations and winning grants.

No part of the net carnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of or be distributed to its members, officers, directors, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services



rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth herein. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provisions of these Articles, the corporation shall not carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on by a corporation exempt from Federal Income Tax under Section 501(c)(3), of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law).

TIT **BOARD OF DIRECTORS**

The affairs of the corporation shall be managed by a board of directors consisting of not less than three (3) persons, as determined pursuant to provisions of the Bylaws. The method of election of directors shall be as stated in the Bylaws.



Upon the dissolution of the corporation, the board of directors shall, after paying or making provisions for the payment of all of the liabilities of the corporation, dispose of all of the assets of the corporation exclusively for the purposes for which this corporation was organized to such organization or organizations organized and operated exclusively for charitable and educational purposes as shall at the time qualify as an exempt organization or organizations under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law) or an organization or organizations, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170(c)(1) or (2) of the Internal Revenue Law or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not disposed of shall be disposed of by the Circuit Court of Sarasota County, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.

XII, AMENDMENT

This corporation reserves the right to amend, alter, change, or repeal any provisions contained in these Articles of Incorporation, or any amendment hereto, in the manner provided in the Bylaws.
