# ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF LATINITOS FOUNDATION INC.

# ARTICLE I NAME

# ARTICLE VIII AMENDMENT

These Articles of Incorporation may be amended in the manner provided by law. # ARTICLE IX LIMITATIONS

- 1. - 2. No substantial part of the activities of this corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation. This corporation shall not participate or intervene in any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office, including the publishing or distribution of statements.
- 3. No withstanding any other activities not permitted to be carried on by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under \$501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1934 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law, or by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible \$170(c)(2) of the Internal Rovenue Code of 1934 or corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law.

# ARTICLE X DISSOLUTION

On the dissolution of this corporation, the board of directors shall dispose of all of the assets of this corporation exclusively for the purposes of this corporation in the manner of the organizations that are organized and operated exclusively for charitable, educational, religious or scientific purposes and that shall at the time qualify as exempt organizations under \$501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1934 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law, after paying or making provisions for the payment of all liabilities of this corporation. Any assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by a court of competent jurisdiction in the county where the principal office of this corporation is then located exclusively for the purpose or to the organizations that the court determines are organized and operate exclusively for charitable, educational, religious or scientific purposes.

The qualifications for and manner of admission of members shall be regulated by the bylaws.
