ARTICLE I - NAME

ARTICLE II

PRINCIPAL PLACE OF CORPORATION AND MAILING ADDRESS

ARTICLE III -- PURPOSES

- 1.- The specific purpose for which the corporation is organized is to preach the good news of salvation of God in all places. To heal and restore the hearts of humanity in all parts of the world and help their relationship with God. To give them spiritual paternity and restore the identities of the sons and daughters of God. Substantiate them in the morals of Christianity and help every person to discover and comply to their purpose, their calling, and the will of God in their lives. Help the peoples to create and form the characteristics of Christ in their lives and proclaim that Jesus Christ is our Lord.
- 2. To use and apply the whole or any part of the income receive exclusively for charitable, religious and educational purposes to all our members and parish oner or by contributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code and Regulations.

- 5.- To conduct bible and theological studies, to educate and prepare the people and create news leaders to serve in the different ministerial ranks and levels. To offer spiritual support and counseling services to people with personal problems and necessity.
- 6.- To borrow money and to issue evidences of indebtedness in furtherance of any or allof the objects of its business: and to secure loans by mortgage, pledge, deed of trust, or other lien.
- 7.- To apply for, obtain and contract with any federal, state or local government or agency for a direct loan or loans or other financial aid in the form of grants or otherwise relating to the purpose of this corporation.
- 8.- To engage in any kind of activity, and to enter into, perform and carry ou: contracts of any kind, necessary or in connection with, or incidental to the accomplishment of any one or more of the non-profit purposes of the corporation.
- 9.- Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any activities no permitted to be conducted or carried by an organization exempt from taxation under Section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code and Regulations issued pursuant thereto as they now exist or as they may hereafter be amended or by and organization, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170 (c) (2) of the Internal Revenue Code and said Regulations as they now exist or as they may hereafter be amended.
- 10.- the corporation shall have such powers as are conferred upon it by Charter
- 11. The corporation shall have such powers as are conferred upon it by Chapter 617 of the Laws of the States of Florida and to exercise those powers in the accomplishments of its objects and purposes.
- 12.- The By-Laws may impose other conditions of memberships from time to time to

ARTICLE IV

INCORPORATORS (S) AND BOARD OF DIRECTORS

ARTICLE IX - AMENDMENTS

No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be carrying on each propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation or intervene in any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office.

ARTICLE XI

DISTRIBUTION OF ASSETS UPON DISSOLUTION

No person, firm or corporation shall ever receive any dividends or profits from the undertaking of this corporation and upon dissolution of this organization all c f its assets remaining after payment of all costs and expenses of such dissolution shall be distributed to organizations which have qualified for exemption under Section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the Federal Government, or to a State or Local government, for a public purpose, an none of the assets will be distributed to any member, officer or trustee of this corporation.
