Articles of Incorporation of

PROFESSIONAL OPTICIANS OF FLORIDA EDUCATION

FOUNDATION, INC.

a Florida not for profit corporation

The undersigned Incorporator hereby adopts and files these Articles of Incorporation pursuant

to the Florida Not for Profit Corporation Act, Chapter 617, in order to form a not for profit

corporation under the laws of the State of Florida.

ARTICLE I.

<u>Name</u>

The name of this Corporation shall be PROFESSIONAL OPTICIANS OF FLORIDA

EDUCATION FOUNDATION, INC.

ARTICLE II.

Address

The street address of the initial principal office of this Corporation shall be

ARTICLE III.

Corporate Purposes

The Corporation is organized to provide optical education and resources to Florida's licensed

Opticians and shall be a nonprofit organization formed and operated exclusively for educational and

charitable purposes within the meaning of Section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the

corresponding section of any future Federal tax code. The Corporation shall not carry on any

activities not permitted to be carried on by a corporation exempt from federal income tax pursuant to Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code and to which deductible contributions may be made under Sections 170, 2055, or 2522 of the Internal Revenue Code, as applicable. No part of the assets or the net earnings of the Corporation shall inure to the benefit of any officer, director, member, or any other person; provided, however, the Corporation is authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in these Articles. No substantial part of the activities of the Corporation shall be dedicated to attempting to influence legislation by propaganda or otherwise. The Corporation shall not participate or intervene in any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office.

ARTICLE IV. Term of Corporate Existence

This Corporation shall have perpetual existence unless dissolved according to law.

ARTICLE V. Corporate Powers

This Corporation shall have and exercise all the powers accorded not for profit corporations under the laws of the State of Florida which are not in conflict with the Corporation's exempt purposes as provided hereinabove.

ARTICLE VI. Members

The Corporation shall have no members. The management of the affairs of the Corporation shall be vested in a Board of Directors, as defined in the Corporation's Bylaws.

ARTICLE VII. Board of Directors

The powers of the Corporation shall be exercised by or under the authority of, and the affairs of the Corporation shall be managed under the direction of a Board of Directors, the number of which may be either increased or decreased from time to time as regulated by the Bylaws but shall consist of not fewer than three (3). The manner and method of election of the Board of Directors shall be as stated in the Bylaws of the Corporation. Where not inconsistent with Chapter 617, Florida Statutes, and the express provisions of these Articles, the Board of Directors shall have all the rights, powers, and privileges prescribed by law of directors of corporations for profit. The initial Board of Directors of the Corporation shall consist of fifteen (15) members, as set forth below, who shall hold office for such terms as provided in the Bylaws of the Corporation and until their successors have been elected and qualified or until their earlier resignation, removal from office, inability to act, or death:

The Corporation may have such other officers and assistant officers and agents as the Board of Directors may deem necessary, to be elected by the Board of Directors or chosen in such other manner as prescribed by the Bylaws.

ARTICLE X. Amendment

These Articles of Incorporation may be amended in any manner now or hereafter provided for by law, and all rights conferred hereunder are granted subject to this reservation.

ARTICLE XI. Personal Liability

No officer or director of this Corporation shall be personally liable for the debts or obligations of the Corporation of any nature whatsoever, nor shall any of the property or assets of the officers or directors be subject to the payment of the debts or obligations of this Corporation.

ARTICLE XII. <u>Dissolution</u>

Upon dissolution, all of the Corporation's assets remaining after payment of all costs and expenses of such dissolution shall be distributed for an exempt purpose to any organization which shall then be qualified for exemption under Section 501(c)(3) and to which a contribution shall be permitted as a deduction under Sections 170, 2055, or 2522 as applicable, or to the federal government, or to a state or local government for a public purpose. None of the assets shall be

distributed to any officer or director of the Corporation, or any other person or organization not described in the preceding sentence.
