Articles of Incorporation Of

The Field Alliance, Inc.

(In Compliance with Chapter 617, F.S., Not for Profit)

Article 1.

The name of the corporation is The Field Alliance, Inc.

Article 2.

The initial registered office of the Corporation shall be at: 3530 Turningwind Lane, Winter Garden, FL 34787. The initial registered agent of the Corporation at such address shall be: Julie Kruger.

Article 3.

The name and address of the incorporator is:

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Article 4.

The initial principal office address of the Corporation shall be at: 3530 Turningwind Ln., Winter Garden, FL 34787.

Article 5.

Said organization is organized exclusively for charitable, religious, educational, and scientific purposes, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code. Specific purpose is to improve the livelihood of the poor rural farming communities, preservation of natural resources and minimize negative impacts to health and the environment.

Any such assets not disposed of shall be disposed of by a Court of Competent Jurisdiction of the County in which the principal office of the Corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.

Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from Federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or (b) by a corporation.
