ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF MARSONI FOUNDATION INC A Florida Corporation Not for Profit

The undersigned incorporator hereby files these Articles of Incorporation to form a non-stock, perpetually existing corporation not for profit pursuant to Chapter 617, Florida Statutes, as amended.

ARTICLE I

<u>Name</u>

The name of this corporation shall be **MARSONI FOUNDATION INC**. The mailing address of the Corporation shall be **11300 NW 87TH Court**, **Suite 141**, **Hialeah FL 33018**.

ARTICLE II

Purposes

Section 1. The Corporation is organized exclusively for charitable, educational purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1 986, as amended (the "Code").

Section 2. Without in any way limiting the foregoing general purposes, the specific purposes of the Corporation shall be to provide primary and basic health preventive services and support facility for the local community including people with substance abuse and other related emotional problems.

ARTICLE III

<u>Powers</u>

Except as limited by these Articles of incorporation or its Bylaws, the Corporation shall have and exercise all rights and powers in furtherance of its purposes as are now or may hereafter be conferred on not for profit corporations pursuant to Chapter 617, Florida Statutes, and other applicable law.

ARTICLE IV Limitations on Activities

Section 1. No part of the net earnings of the Corporation shall inure to the benefit of or benefit of or benefit of the corporation or any other private individual (except that reasonable compensation may be paid for services rendered to or for the Corporation effecting one or more of its purposes as set forth in Article II hereof), and no member, director or officer of the Corporation, or any other private individual, shall be entitled to share in the distribution of any of the corporate assets upon dissolution of the Corporation; provided, however, that the Corporation may confer benefits in the form of distributions, in dissolution or otherwise in the manner set forth in Article V hereof

Section 2. The Corporation shall not, as a substantial part of its activities, carry on propaganda, lobby, or otherwise attempt to influence legislation. The Corporation shall not participate in any political campaign on behalf of (or in opposition to) any candidate for public office.

Section 3. Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles of Incorporation, the Corporation shall not conduct or carry on any activities which may not be conducted or carried on by an organization exempt from taxation under Section 501(c)(3) of the Code or by an organization contributions to which are deductible by the donor under Section 170(c)(2) of the Code.

Section 4. The Corporation shall use or distribute its income for each taxable year at such time and in such manner as not to become subject to tax on undistributed income imposed by Section 4942 of the Code.

Section 5. The Corporation shall not engage in any act of self-dealing as defined in Section 4941(d) of the Code.

Section 6. The Corporation shall not retain any excess business holdings as defined in Section 4943(c) of the Code.

Section 7. The Corporation shall not make any investments in such manner as to subject the Corporation to tax under Section 4944 of the Code.

Section 8. The Corporation shall not make any taxable expenditures as defined in Section 4945(d) of the Code.

Upon the dissolution of the Corporation, the Directors of the Corporation shall, after paying or making provisions for the payment of all of the liabilities of the Corporation, distribute all residual assets of the Corporation to such organization or organizations organized and operated exclusively for charitable, educational or scientific purposes which. at the time of such disposition, qualify as an exempt organization or organizations under Sections S01(c)(3) and 170(c)(2) of the Code, and which has as its primary purpose provide primary and basic health preventive services and support facility for the local community including people with substance abuse and other related emotional problems. Any assets not so distributed shall be distributed by a court of competent jurisdiction exclusively for the aforementioned purposes, or to such organization or organizations organized and operated exclusively for the aforementioned purposes.
