ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

LONGWOOD BAPTIST MISSIONS, INC.

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ARTICLE I CORPORATE NAME

The name of the corporation is: LONGWOOD BAPTIST MISSIONS, INC.

ARTICLE II CORPORATE ADDRESS

The principal place of business and mailing address of the Corporation is:

543 Matilda Place Longwood, Florida 32750-3301

ARTICLE III DURATION

The term of existence of the corporation is perpetual.

ARTICLE IV GENERAL AND SPECIFIC PURPOSES

Section 1 - General Purpose

LONGWOOD BAPTIST MISSIONS, INC. is organized for the purpose of operating an independent, nonprofit Baptist Church and Mission, conducting prayer meetings and bible studies for members and guests, and engaging in Baptist mission work to educate and inform persons about the beliefs, teachings and philosophy of the Christian Baptist religion through charitable and educational ministries, and providing a place of religious worship for members and guests.

Section II - Corporate Powers under Chapter 617

LONGWOOD BAPTIST MISSIONS, INC. is authorized to exercise all the corporation powers consistent with the foregoing purposes that are possessed by nonprofit corporations organized under Chapter 617, Florida Statutes, and future amendments thereto (or any successor codification of Florida law governing nonprofit corporation) and that are not inconsistent with the qualification of the corporation for tax exempt status under Sections 501(c)(3)

of the U.S. Internal Revenue Code, as a corporation organized and operated exclusively for religious, charitable and educational purposes.

Section III - Internal Revenue Service

Said corporation is organized exclusively for charitable, religious, and educational purposes, including the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under Sec. 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code or the corresponding section of any future Federal income tax code.

No part of the net earnings of the organization shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to, its members, Directors, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article IV hereof.

No part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempt to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office.

Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on

- (a) by an organization exempt from Federal income tax under Sec. 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future Federal income tax code, or
- (b) by an organization, contributions to which are deductible under Sec. 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future Federal income tax code.

ARTICLE V AFFILIATION

LONGWOOD BAPTIST MISSIONS, INC. shall operate as an independent Baptist organization, unless otherwise provided in the Bylaws.

ARTICLE VI MEMBERS

Members of LONGWOOD BAPTIST MISSIONS, INC. shall be determined as provided in the Bylaws, and membership voting rights or nonvoting rights shall be determined by the Bylaws.

ARTICLE VII BOARD OF DIRECTORS

The Board of Directors of the corporation shall be members in good standing. The manner in which the Directors are elected or appointed shall be set forth in the Bylaws.

The Directors named herein as the first Board of Directors shall hold office until their successors are elected or appointed and qualified. The names and addresses of the first members of the Board of Directors are as follows:

ARTICLE VIII DISSOLUTION

Upon dissolution of the corporation, all real and personal property of the corporation shall be distributed to any nonprofit corporation operating an independent Baptist church located in the State of Florida, selected by majority vote of the Board of Directors, or, in the alternative, as selected by a Court of competent jurisdiction of the county in which the principal office of the corporation is then located.
