

Articles of Incorporation Of

Bridges for Bethlehem, Inc.

(In Compliance with Chapter 617, F.S., Not for Profit)

Article 1.

The name of the corporation is Bridges for Bethlehem. Inc.

Article 2.

The initial registered office of the Corporation shall be at: 201 S. Alcaniz St., Pensacola, FL 32502. The initial registered agent of the Corporation at such address shall be: Diana Toups.

Article 3.

The name and address of the incorporator is:

Article 4.

The initial principal office address of the Corporation shall be at: 201 S. Alcaniz St., Pensacola, FL 32502

The initial mailing address of the Corporation shall be at: 2430 W. Bayshore Rd., Gulf Breeze, FL 32563

Article 5.

Said organization is organized exclusively for charitable, religious, educational, and scientific purposes, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code. Specific purpose is to provide assistance to underprivileged families through items including, but not limited to, educational scholarships, school supplies, meals, hygiene supplies, clothing and tutoring.

Article 6.

The Corporation shall have perpetual duration.

Article 7.

The affairs of the Corporation shall be managed by a Board of Directors. The number of Directors of the Corporation and method of election shall be set out more specifically in the bylaws. Initial Board Members are:

Article 8.

Upon dissolution of the Corporation, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not disposed of shall be disposed of by a Court of Competent Jurisdiction of the County in which the principal office of the Corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.

Article 9.

No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of section 501(c)(3) purposes. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be carrying on of propaganda, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office.

Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from Federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under section 170 (c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.
