

## AMENDED AND RESTATED ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF MAGDALENE'S, INC. A FLORIDA "NOT FOR PROFIT" CORPORATION DE LETABLY OF STATE

TALLAHASSEE, FLORIGA

We, the undersigned natural persons, of the age of twenty-one years or more, acting as incorporators of a corporation pursuant to the Florida Not For Profit Corporation Act, Chapter 617, Florida Statutes, as amended (the "Florida Not for Profit Corporation Act"), do adopt the following Amended and Restated Articles of Incorporation, which amend and restate in its entirety those certain Articles of Incorporation adopted on May 31, 2020.

## ARTICLE I NAME OF CORPORATION

The name of the corporation is Magdalene's, Inc. ("Magdalene's").

#### ARTICLE II PRINCIPAL OFFICE

The principal office of Magdalene's is located at 3268 Fordham Parkway, Gulf Breeze, Florida 32563.

## ARTICLE III MAILING ADDRESS

The mailing address of Magdalene's is 3268 Fordham Parkway, Gulf Breeze, Florida 32563.

## ARTICLE IV REGISTERED AGENT

The name of the registered agent of Magdalene's is Jackie B. Bell. The address of the registered agent is Magdalene's, Inc., 3268 Fordham Parkway, Gulf Breeze, Florida 32563.

#### ARTICLE V DURATION

Magdalene's shall have perpetual existence or until such time as the Board of Directors of Magdalene's shall adopt a resolution recommending that Magdalene's be dissolved pursuant to the Florida Not for Profit Corporation Act.

#### ARTICLE VI MEMBERSHIP

The provisions regarding membership shall be set forth in the Bylaws.

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#### ARTICLE VII BOARD OF DIRECTORS

The provisions regarding the Board of Directors of Magdalene's shall be set forth in the Bylaws.

#### ARTICLE VIII INCORPORATORS

## ARTICLE IX CORPORATE PURPOSES

The purposes for which Magdalene's is formed are all legal purposes, including, but not limited to the following, subject to the limitations provided in Article X of these Articles of Incorporation:

- Section 9.1. <u>Aid to Survivors</u>. Helping women survivors of prostitution, trafficking abuse and addiction through Christian-based rehabilitation, therapeutic and vocational programming, and in furtherance thereof, the encouraging, soliciting, receiving, and administering of gifts.
- Section 9.2. <u>Aid, Support and Assist Other 501(c)(3) Entities</u>. To aid, support and assist by gifts, contributions or otherwise, other corporations, community chests, funds and foundations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.
- Section 9.3. <u>All Other Lawful Activities</u>. To do any and all lawful activities which may be necessary, useful, or desirable for the furtherance, accomplishment, fostering, or attaining of the foregoing provisions, either directly or indirectly, and either alone or in conjunction or cooperation with others, whether such others be persons or organizations of any kind or nature, such as corporations, firms, associations, trusts, institutions, foundations, or governmental bureaus, departments or agencies.

## ARTICLE X 501(C)(3) LIMITATIONS

Section 10.1. <u>Corporate Purposes</u>. Notwithstanding any other provisions of these Articles of Incorporation, Magdalene's shall not carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by an organization exempt from federal tax under section 50I(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue

Code or the corresponding provision of any future federal tax code, or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding provision of any future federal tax code.

**Section 10.2.** Exclusivity. Magdalene's is organized exclusively for charitable and religious purposes.

Section 10.3. <u>No Private Inurement</u>. Magdalene's is not organized nor shall it be operated for the primary purpose of generating pecuniary gain or profit. Magdalene's shall not distribute any gains, profits or dividends to the directors, officers, or members thereof (if any), or to any individual, except as reasonable compensation for services actually performed in carrying out Magdalene's charitable and religious purposes. The property, assets, profits and net income of Magdalene's are irrevocably dedicated to charitable and religious purposes no part of which shall inure to the benefit of any individual.

Section 10.4. <u>Advocacy and Political Campaigns</u>. No substantial part of the activities of Magdalene's shall consist of the carrying on of propaganda or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and Magdalene's shall not participate in, or intervene in, any political campaign on behalf of (or in opposition to) any candidate for public office

Section 10.5. <u>Dissolution</u>. Upon winding up and dissolution of Magdalene's, the assets of Magdalene's remaining after payment of all debts and liabilities shall be distributed to an organization recognized as exempt under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code to be used exclusively for charitable and religious purposes, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. If Magdalene's holds any assets in trust, such assets shall be disposed of in such a manner as may be directed by decree of the Circuit Court of the district in which Magdalene's principal office is located, upon petition thereof by the Attorney General or by any person concerned in the liquidation.

Section 10.6. Private Foundation Status. In the event that Magdalene's shall become a "private foundation" within the meaning of Section 509 of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, Magdalene's shall distribute its income for each taxable year at such time and in such manner as not to subject it to tax under section 4942 of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code; shall not engage in any act of self-dealing as defined in section 4941(d) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code; shall not retain any excess business holdings as defined in section 4943(c) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code; shall not make any investments in such manner as to subject it to tax under section n4944 of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code; and shall not make any taxable expenditures as defined in section 4945(d) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

## ARTICLE XI CORPORATE POWERS

Magdalene's shall have all powers allowed a corporation not for profit under the laws of the State of Florida, including the Florida Not for Profit Corporation Act, except for powers which would endanger Magdalene's status as a section 501(c)(3) organization.

## ARTICLE XII BYLAWS

The Board of Directors, by a majority vote of all directors then in office, shall make or amend Bylaws to govern the management and administration of Magdalene's, in a manner not inconsistent with these Articles of Incorporation.

## ARTICLE XIII AMENDMENTS

The provisions regarding amendments shall be set forth in the Bylaws.

## ARTICLE XIV INDEMNIFICATION

The provisions regarding indemnification shall be set forth in the Bylaws.

## ARTICLE XV ADOPTION BY BOARD OF DIRECTORS

These amended and restated articles were adopted by unanimous vote of the Board of Directors on January 30, 2023, and do not contain any amendments requiring member approval.
