ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION In compliance with Chapter 617, F.S., (Not for Profit) 2020 APR 16 AM 11:00

Article | - Name

The name of the Corporation shall be: Manufacturing Technology Deployment Group, Inc.

Article II - Principal Office

The principal street and mailing address shall be:

13555 Automobile Blvd, Suite 370 Clearwater, FL 33762

Article III - Purpose

The Corporation is incorporated under the Florida Not For Profit Corporation Act and shall be organized and operated exclusively for charitable, scientific, literary and educational purposes permitted within the scope of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, including, without limitation, the oversight of, management of, and support of the National Center for Defense Manufacturing and Machining.

Further, in its oversight, management and support role, the Corporation shall:

- (a) Manage and provide oversight and support of the National Center for Defense Manufacturing and Machining;
- (b) Oversee the establishment and implementation of a long-term strategic development plan that supports services by the National Center for Defense Manufacturing and Machining which benefit the public and potentially lessen the burdens of government;
- (c) Support and assist the National Center for Defense Manufacturing and Machining in developing and raising the funds necessary for its financial support; and
- (d) Generally take any action which shall promote all or any of the foregoing purposes.

In furtherance of these purposes, the Corporation may exercise all rights and powers conferred by the laws of the State of Florida upon not for profit corporations.

Article IV – Directors and Manner of Election

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The Corporation shall be governed by a Board of Directors which shall consist of such numbers of directors as may be fixed from time to time by the Board of Directors of the Corporation in its bylaws, but in no event shall the Board of Directors of the Corporation consist of fewer than three (3) directors. In addition, at all times at least one of the directors of the Corporation shall also be a director of the National Center for Defense Manufacturing and Machining. The method of election of directors will be stated in the bylaws.

Article V – Initial Officers and/or Directors

The Initial Directors, with the Office for each, shall be:

Article VI - Registered Agent

Article VII – Incorporator

Article VIII – Effective Date

These Articles of Incorporation shall be effective upon filing.

Article IX – Supported Organizations

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The Corporation is to be operated as a supporting organization under Section 509(a)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended. The Corporation shall support the National Center for Defense Manufacturing and Machining, a Pennsylvania nonprofit corporation and charitable organization under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended. The Corporation shall only operate to support and benefit the National Center for Defense Manufacturing and Machining.

Article X – Prohibitions

The Corporation does not contemplate pecuniary gain or profit, incidental or otherwise. No part of the net earnings of the Corporation shall inure to the benefit of any director or officer of the Corporation or any private individual (except that reasonable compensation may be paid for services rendered to or for the Corporation effecting one or more of its purposes), and no director or officer of the Corporation, or any private individual, shall be entitled to share in the distribution of any of the corporate assets on dissolution of the Corporation. No substantial part of the activities of the Corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the Corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publication or distribution of statements), any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office.

Article XI - Jurisdiction

The Corporation is incorporated under the Florida Not For Profit Corporation Act.

Article XII - Stock

The Corporation is to be organized on a nonstock basis.

Article XIII - Members

The Corporation shall have no members.

Article XIV - Term

The term of existence of the Corporation shall be perpetual.

Article XV – Prohibited Activities

Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles of Incorporation, the Corporation, shall not conduct or carry on any activities not permitted to be conducted or carried on by an organization described in Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, and its regulations, as they now exist or as they may hereafter be amended. In addition, notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles of Incorporation, the Corporation shall not conduct or carry on any activities not permitted to be conducted or carried on by an organization contributions to which are deductible under Section 170 of said Internal Revenue Code and its regulations, as they now exist or as they may hereafter be amended.

Article XVI – Dissolution

Upon dissolution of the Corporation or the winding up of its affairs, the Board of Directors shall, after making provision for the payment of all of the liabilities of the Corporation, dispose of all of the assets of the Corporation exclusively for the purposes of the Corporation in such manner or to such organizations which are described in Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, or the corresponding provisions of any subsequent United States Internal Revenue law, as the Board of Directors shall determine.
