ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF QUINCY CHURCH OF GOD OF PROPHECY, INC. 2: 31

An Florida Nonprofit Corporation

METABLESS F

The undersigned, desiring to form a not for profit corporation in accordance with the Florida Ne For Profit Corporation Act, hereby adopt the following Articles of Incorporation.

ARTICLE I NAME AND PLACE OF BUSINESS

Section 1.1 The name of the Corporation is Quincy Church of God of Prophecy, Inc., Florida not for profit corporation. Its principal place of business at 331 Kent Street, Quincy, Florida 32333.

ARTICLE II PURPOSES, LIMITATIONS AND DISSOLUTIONS

- Section 2.1 <u>Purposes</u>. The Corporation is organized as a Christian church within the Church o God of Prophecy, Cleveland, Tennessee, and for all other lawful purposes. It is specifically organized a a church, exclusively for charitable, religious, educational, and scientific purposes under § 501(c)(3) o the Internal Revenue Code or corresponding section of any future federal tax code (The "Code") and the Regulations issued thereunder (the "Regulations") and (1) to reveive, manintain and administer assests it perpetuity for such purposes, and (2) to use and apply the whole or any part of the principal and incomplete from for such purposes either directly or by contributions to other organization that qualify as exemptorganizations under the Code.
- Section 2.2 <u>Limitations on Actions.</u> No part of the net earnings of the Corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributed to its Members. Directors, Officers, or other private persons, except that the Corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in these Articles of Incorporation. No substantial part of the activities of the Corporation shall be the carrying on opropaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the Corporation shall not participate in or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behal of or in opposition to any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles, the Corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on by (a) a corporation exempt from the federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the *Internal Revenue Code*, of the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or (b) a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170(c)(2) of the *Internal Revenue Code* or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.
- Section 2.3 <u>Dissolution</u>. Upon the dissolution of the Corporation, the Board of Directors shall after paying or making provision for the payment of all of the liablities of the corporation, transfer al remaining assets to The Church of God of Prophecy State Offices in Florida, Inc., a Florida not-for-proficorporation. In the event that the The Church of God of Prophecy State Offices in Florida, Inc. ceases to

exist, then the Directors shall dispose of all of the assets of the corporation Church of God of Prophec located at Cleveland, Tennessee. In the event that the Church of God of Prophecy located at Cleveland Tennessee ceases to exist, then the Directors shall dispose of all of the assets of the corporation exclusivel for the purposes of the corporation in such a manner, or to such organization or organizations organize and operated exclusively for religious, charitable, educational, scientific or literary purposes as shall at the time qualify as an exempt organization or organizations under Section 501(c)(3) of the Code as the Boar of Directors shall determine, or to federal, state, or local governments to be used exclusively for publi purposes. Any such assets not so disposed shall be disposed of by the Circuit Court of the county in which the principal office of the corporation is located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization such as the court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes, or to such governments for such purposes.

III. DURATION

The term of existence of the Corporation is perpetual. The corporate existence will commenc upon the filing of these Articles of Incorporation.

IV. MEMBERS

The Corporation shall have members. The rights of members shall be as set out in the By-Law of the Corporation.

V. DIRECTORS
