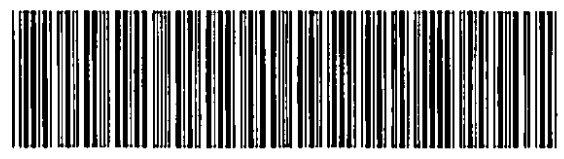

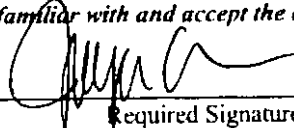

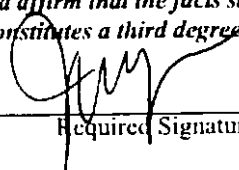

Attachment to Articles of Incorporation for Florida Not For Profit Articles of Incorporation

Figure It Out Farm Inc.

Article III. Purpose

The purpose for which the corporation is organized is to engage in such exclusively charitable, scientific, literary and educational activities of any kind or nature whatsoever as shall qualify it for exemption from taxation under Section 501 (a) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended (the "Code"), or corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law, as an organization describe in Section 501 (c) (3) of the Code, including, in particular to promote inclusion and acceptance of autistic individuals into their local communities, to provide meaningful work and residential opportunities and to maintain emotional and social ties with family by staying in or close to their home town.

In furtherance of the foregoing purposes, the Corporation shall have all the general powers now or hereafter permitted by law for a corporation organized for the foregoing purposes including the power to solicit grants and contributions for any of the foregoing purposes; provided, however, that, notwithstanding any other provision of this certificate.

1. The corporation shall not carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from Federal income tax under Section 501 (c) (3) of the Code, or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170 (c) (2) of the Code;
2. No part of the net earnings of the Corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its directors, officers, or other private persons, except that the Corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purpose set forth in this certificate. No substantial part of the activities of the Corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda or otherwise attempting to influence legislation and the Corporation shall no participate in or intervene in (including publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office; and
3. Upon dissolution of the Corporation, the board of trustees shall, after paying or making provision for the payment of all the liabilities of the Corporation, dispose of all of the remaining assets of the Corporation exclusively for such charitable, scientific, literary, education or other exempt purposes, within the meaning of Section 501 © (3) of the Code or corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law, or to such exempt purposes, as the board of trustees shall determine. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by order of the Superior Court of the State of Florida in the judicial district where the principal office of the Corporation is then located, exclusively for such exempt purposes or to such organization and operated exclusively for such exempt purposes as said court shall determine.
