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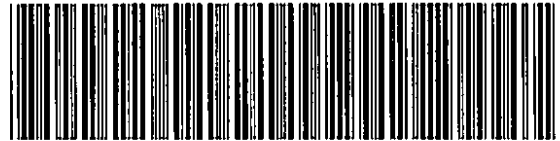

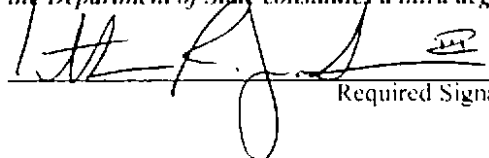

Distribution of Assets Upon the Dissolution of the Corporation

Article IX

- (a) No part of net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to, its members, directors, officers or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of purposes set forth in these articles of incorporation. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf or in opposition to any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provisions permitted to be carried on by the following:
- a corporation exempt from federal income tax under 501©(3) of the code, or
 - a corporation to which the contributions are tax deductible under 170©(2) of the code.
- (b) Upon the dissolution of the corporation, its assets remaining after payment of, or provision for payment of, all debts and liabilities of this corporation shall be distributed to a non-profit fund, foundation, or corporation, which is organized and operated exclusively for public benefit or religious purposes as under Section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by the Superior Court of the county in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.
