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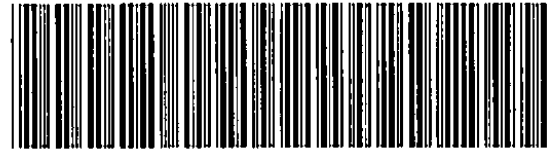

Articles of Incorporation
Moving Forward Sarasota, Inc.
A Florida Not for Profit Corporation

The undersigned, a citizen of the State of Florida, desiring to form a not for profit organization incorporated under the Florida Not for Profit Corporation Act (Chapter 617 F.S.), does hereby certify:

ARTICLE I - NAME

The name of the corporation shall be **Moving Forward Sarasota, Inc.**

ARTICLE II – PRINCIPAL OFFICE

The principal place of business and mailing address of the corporation is 1254 May Lane, Sarasota FL 34230.

ARTICLE III - PURPOSE

The organization is organized exclusively for charitable, religious, educational, and scientific purposes under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of future federal tax code

ARTICLE IV – MANNER OF ELECTION OF DIRECTORS

The directors shall be elected or re-elected by members of the Board of Directors as provided in the By-Laws.

ARTICLE VII – USE OF CORPORATE EARNINGS

No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes described in section 501(c)(3). No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

ARTICLE VIII DISTRIBUTION OF CORPORATE ASSETS UPON DISSOLUTION OF CORPORATE

Upon the dissolution of the corporation, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by a court of competent jurisdiction of the county in which

principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to serve one or more other organizations or organizations, as said court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purpose.


