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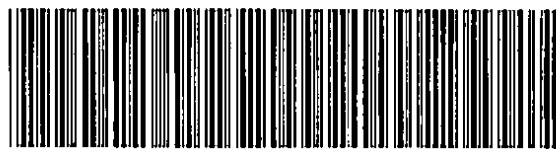

- First, it is our mission to aid animal shelters by providing pet toys for animals in need to further their well-being
- Second, it is our mission to provide a service project for individuals and organization that allows them to give back using few resources
- Third, it is our mission to promote sustainability through reducing waste by encouraging the use of materials in our project that would otherwise be discarded
