#### Articles of Incorporation Attachment

#### ARTICLE III PURPOSE

- 1. To operate exclusively for charitable, educational and religious purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c) 3 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, or corresponding section of any future tax code and generally to engage in any other lawful endeavor or activity in furtherance of any of the foregoing purposes.
- 2. The Church Unusual, Inc.'s mission is to reach souls that are lost, hurt and abandoned. Our assignment is to heal the sick and deliver the lost. Appointed, Anointed, Assigned and ordained by the Holy Spirit, express care and restoration through the demonstration of God's power.
- 3. The Church Unusual, Inc.'s envisions being a Bible-based, five-fold ministry governed by the Apostolic; Christian fellowship which provides worship, training, and world-wide evangelism and missions in a culturally and ethnically diverse environment.
  - a. Promote and encourage, through ministries of the organization, cooperation with other organizations ministering within the community.
  - b. Spread the Word of the Gospel by ministering to all through seminars, radio, television, and other forms of mass media.
  - c. Conduct a school for ministers and leaders.
  - d. License and ordain qualified individuals including graduates of ministerial schools.
- 4. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall consist of the carrying on of propaganda or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in, any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office.

#### ARTICLE IV MANNER OF ELECTION

- 1. The manner in which the directors are elected and appointed: The initial Board of Directors shall be appointed by the incorporators and thereafter shall be elected by the Board of Directors at a regular meeting of the Board of Directors to be held at the principle office of Church Unusual, Inc. or such other place as may be fixed by the Board. Directors who are elected shall serve for a term of one (1) year, or until his or her successor is elected and qualifies, subject, however to the removal of any Director as allowed by applicable law or Church Unusual, Inc.'s byławs
- 2. Discrimination during Elections. Discrimination in election and nominating procedures on the basis of race, color, creed, gender, age, marital status, national origin, physical or mental disability, or unlawful purpose is prohibited.

#### **ARTICLE IX DISSOLUTION**

- 1. The property of this corporation is irrevocably dedicated to charitable purposes and no part of the net income or assets of this corporation shall ever inure to the benefit of any director, officer, or member thereof or to the benefit of any private person.
- 2. The manner of distribution of assets in this Corporation's winding up is as follows: Upon dissolution of the Corporation, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or state or local government for public purpose. Any such asset not so disposed of shall be disposed of by the Court of Competent Jurisdiction of the county in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purpose or to such organization or organizations as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.

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
