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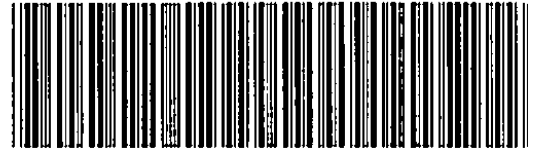

**NONPROFIT ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
DECODING DYSLEXIA FLORIDA INC.**

The undersigned, a natural person over the age of eighteen years, hereby certify as follows:

ARTICLE 1. NAME

The name of this corporation shall be DECODING DYSLEXIA FLORIDA INC., (hereinafter referred to as "Corporation").

ARTICLE 2. PRINCIPAL PLACE OF BUSINESS

The Principal place of business and mailing address of the Corporation is 3447 Tarpon Wood Palm Harbor, FL 34685.

ARTICLE 3. DURATION

The period of duration of the Corporation is perpetual.

ARTICLE 4. PURPOSE

- 4 No member, officer, or director of this Corporation shall be personally liable for the debts or obligations of this Corporation of any nature whatsoever, nor shall any of the property of the members, officers, or directors be subject to the payment of the debts or obligations of this Corporation.
