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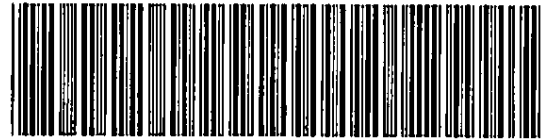

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
SAFE HARBOR HOUSE OF TRANSFORMATION, INC.
(A Florida Not-For-Profit)

Article I. Name

The name of the corporation shall be: Safe Harbor House of Transformation, Inc.

Article II. Principal Office

The specific purpose for which the corporation is organized is as follows:



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

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
