Sister's Keepers Inc. is organized exclusively for charitable, religious, and educational purposes included for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal code. No part of the net earnings of Sister's Keeper Inc. shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributal to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in the purpose clause hereof.

No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or interver in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, t corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by any corporative exempt from federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which deductible under section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

Sister's Keeper Inc., is not organized and shall not be operated for the private gain of any person. The property of the corporation is irrevocably dedicated to its educational and charitable purposes. No proof the assets, receipts, or net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributed to any individual. The corporation may, however, pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and make other payments and distributions consistent with these Articles.

Upon the dissolution of Sister's Keepers Inc., any assets lawfully available for distribution shall be distributed to one or more qualifying organizations described in section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 which organization(s) have a charitable purpose which, at least generally, includes a purpose similar to Sister's Keeper Inc.

The organization to receive the assets of Sister's Keeper hereunder shall be selected by the discretion a majority of the managing body of Sister's Keeper and if its members cannot so agree, then the recipient organization shall be selected pursuant to a verified petition in equity filed in a court of projurisdiction against Sister's Keeper by one or more of its managing body which verified petition shall contain such statements as reasonably indicate the applicability of this section. The court upon a fine that this section is applicable shall select the qualifying organization(s) to receive the assets to be distributed, giving preference if practicable to organizations located within the State of Florida.

In the event that the court shall find that this section is applicable but that there is no qualifying organization known to it which has a charitable purpose, which, at least generally, includes a purpose similar to this corporation, then the court shall direct the distribution of its assets lawfully available for distribution to the Treasurer of the State of Florida and to be added to the general fund.
