

Attachment to the Articles of Incorporation of Association des Anciens du Collège Notre Dame Inc

Article III Purpose

This corporation is founded exclusively for charitable educational purposes within the meaning of the Internal Revenue Code Section 501(c)(3), namely: To promote educational opportunities for needy students in Haiti and for Haitian American students in Florida or elsewhere in the US, by assisting them in any way possible. Such assistance will include (but not be limited to) educational counseling, private lessons, social events, educational enrichment, home visitations, neighborhood interventions and other helpful activities to encourage disadvantaged youth and their families to strive for excellence. At the sole discretion of the directors, this corporation will provide direct cash grants to disadvantaged students, families and communities when such grants are seen to be in advancement of the education and wellbeing of the recipients or helpful in averting the deterioration of students, families or the community.

This corporation will promote equality of opportunity between social groups, cultures or ethnicities as regards education, with particular attention to the struggles of Haitian American and Haitian students. It will implement seminars, courses, lectures and events to inform the general community concerning the importance of educational equality for the betterment of all society. It will strive the teach about the unique culture and the many positive and uplifting values of the Haitian people and the Haitian American community. In all its actions, this corporation will strive to lessen neighborhood tensions, eliminate prejudice and discrimination, defend human and civil rights, while combating community deterioration.

This corporation will carry out its activities both in the US and in Haiti. The directors will be drawn from the alumni of Collège Notre-Dame du Perpétuel Secours, in Cap Hatien, Haiti. Education professionals serving the African American and Haitian communities as well as other individuals dedicated to the ideals of "education and self-fulfillment for all" will be eligible for election to the board of directors, as set forth in the corporation's bylaws. The directors and officers of this corporation are empowered to carry out the aforementioned actions as well as any other actions which are deemed by them to be conductive to the attainment of the aforementioned goals and objectives.

In the event of this corporation's dissolution, the Directors will –after clearing all debts and liabilities—distribute all remaining funds or assets to other charitable organizations that are recognized as such by the IRS under IRC sec 501(c)(3) and which have goals similar to those of this corporation.
