ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF BETHANY INTERNATIONAL SERVICES, INC.

A NON FOR PROFIT CORPORATION)

The undersigned does hereby make, subscribe and acknowledge that they have voluntarily associated themselves together for the purpose of forming a not for profit corporation, and do here by certify the following as the Articles of Incorporation of such corporation.

ARTICLE I

NAME

The name of this corporation is BETHANY INTERNATIONAL SERVICES. INC

ARTICLE II DURATION

BETHANY INTERNATIONAL SERVICES, INC. shall have a perpetual existence

ARTICLE III REGISTERED AGENT

The name and address of the initial Registered Agent is: Mereline N. Brown. 6874 South Congress Ave. LANTANA, FL 33462. The registered Agent is familiar with and accepts the duties and responsibilities as the Registered Agent.

ARTICLE IV

REGISTERED AGENT MAILING ADDRESS

ARTICLE V PURPOSES

BETHANY INTERNATIONAL SERVICES, INC.is organized and operated exclusively for charitable and education purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code. More particularly, to conduct programs and activities, sponsor research, sponsor promotions, provide cares and distribute healthcare kit, school, and church's temple to underprivileged families and orphans in the community. Notwithstanding any other provision of

these Articles, BETHANY INTERNATIONAL SERVICES, INC. shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (1) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under Section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code or (2) by a corporation contributions to which are deductible under Section 170(c)(2) of said Code, or the corresponding provisions of any future statute of the United States. No substantial part of the activities of BETHANY INTERNATIONAL SERVICES, INC. shall consist of carrying on propaganda or otherwise attempting to influence legislation; nor shall the corporation participate or intervene in any political campaign (including the publishing or distribution of statements) on behalf of any candidate for public office. BETHANY INTERNATIONAL SERVICES, INC.is a nonprofit public benefit corporation and is not organized for the private gain of any person. It is organized under the Nonprofit Public Benefit Corporation Law for charitable and education purposes. BETHANY INTERNATIONAL SERVICES, INC. is organized and operated exclusively for any lawful purpose to retain nonprofit status as set forth in the most current Internal Revenue Code, and to act and operate exclusively as a not for profit Corporation pursuant to the laws of the State of Florida, its municipalities, county governments, and the United States. The Corporation shall be able to assist and help the community which it serves to achieve other charitable actions such as assisting members of the community who are not financially stable to achieve goals that may render their lives a little better. To help and orient young people into adulthood transition. To help and feed the hungry of the community. To guide voung minority children and family in the community to the right direction, in the perspective of building a strong community; but not limited to the USA. BETHANY INTERNATIONAL SERVICES, INC. is a global initiative that aims to serve the needs of the minority and orphans in Africa.

ARTICLE VI

PUBLICLY SUPPORTED TAX-EXEMPT NONPROFIT CORPORATION

No part of BETHANY INTERNATIONAL SERVICES, INC, shall inure to the benefit of its members, directors, officers, or other private persons, except that BETHANY INTERNATIONAL SERVICES, INC, shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article V hereof. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under section 501(c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under section 170(c) (2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

ARTICLE VII INITIAL OFFICERS AND DIRECTORS The names and Street addresses of the officers and directors who are to manage BETHANY INTERNATIONAL SERVICES, INC., until the first annual meeting are:

ARTICLE VIII DISSOLUTION

Upon the dissolution or winding up of BETHANY INTERNATIONAL SERVICES, INC., any assets remaining after payment of, or provision for payment of, all debts and liabilities shall be distributed to a governmental entity described in Section 170(b)(1) (A)(v) of the Internal Revenue Code, or to a nonprofit fund, corporation, or corporation which is organized and operated exclusively for charitable purposes, which has established its tax exempt status under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, and which is qualified to receive "qualified conservation contributions" within the meaning of Section 170(h) of said Code, or the corresponding provisions of any future statute of the United States.

ARTICLE IX CORPORATE POWERS

In addition to all other corporate powers provided by law and in furtherance of the objectives described in Article V, but not in limitation thereof, BETHANY INTERNATIONAL SERVICES, INC., shall have the power to:

- 1. Elect and appoint such officers and agents as its activities shall require and allow them reasonable compensation:
- 2. Adopt, change, amend and repeal bylaws, not consistent with law or its articles of incorporation; and the exercise of its corporate powers;
- 3. Conduct its activities, carry out on its operations, and have offices and exercise the power granted by Florida law in any state, territory, district or possession of the United States or any foreign country;
- 4. Make donations for the public, or for religious, charitable, scientific, educational or other similar purposes:

5. Have and exercise all powers necessary or convenient to effect any or all of the purposes for which BETHANY INTERNATIONAL SERVICES, INC. is organized.

ARTICLE X

The Board of Directors, by majority vote, is authorized to establish bylaws for BETHANY INTERNATIONAL SERVICES, INC., not inconsistent with these Articles of Incorporation, and to amend same from time to time. Directors shall be elected as stated in the bylaws.

ARTICLE XIII

AMENDMENTS TO ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

BETHANY INTERNATIONAL SERVICES, INC., reserves the right to amend or repeal any provisions contained in these Articles of Incorporation. Amendments to the Articles of Incorporation must be adopted by an absolute majority vote of the Board of Directors at any board meeting called for that purpose or by the incorporators when necessary.

ARTICLE XIV

EFFECTIVE DATE

The effective date of BETHANY INTERNATIONAL SERVICES, INC. shall be the day of registration of BETHANY INTERNATIONAL SERVICES, INC. in the State.
