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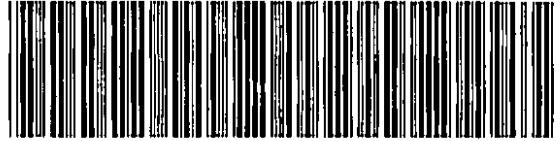

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION FOR
THE KIMKAM CHARITABLE FOUNDATION, INC.

Article I

The name of the Corporation is The KimKam Charitable Foundation, Inc.

Article II

The principal office of the Charitable Foundation, Inc. is located at 1173 Ring Street, Deltona, Florida 32725.

Article III

The Chief Executive Officer is hereby appointed registered agent for the Corporation.

Article IV

The purposes for which the Foundation is organized and the powers with which the Foundation is vested include, but are not limited to, the following:

- a) To collaborate with like organizations in the promotion of positive community advancement,
- a) To offer educational workshops benefiting underserved families and children, and individuals promoting wholistic health and wellness,
- b) To provide community outreach activities such as back-to-school drives, food and clothing drives for underserved families and children, and individuals, and
- c) To empower underserved families and children, and individuals with opportunities for advancement through literacy arts and financial literacy.

Said corporation is organized exclusively for charitable, religious, educational, and scientific purposes, including purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under 26 U.S.C. §501(c)(3) (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law or code). This is a nonprofit corporation and its purposes shall remain nonprofit.

No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributed to, its members directors, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article IV hereof. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not corporate, or intervene (including the publishing or distributing of statements) in political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office.

Article V

Upon dissolution of the corporation, the Board of Directors shall, after paying or making provisions for the payment of all of the liabilities of the corporation, dispose of all of the assets of the corporation exclusively for the purposes of the corporation in such manner, or to such organization or organizations organized and operated exclusively for charitable, educational, religious, or scientific purposes as shall at the time qualify as an exempt organization or organizations under 26 U.S.C. § 501(c)(3) (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law or code), as the Board of Directors shall determine. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by the Circuit Court of the County in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said court such purposes.

Article VI

The Board of Directors shall consist of no less than three (3) nor more than five (5) members. The number of Board of members, manner of election, and term of office shall be provided in the Bylaws.

Additional members may be admitted at any meetings of the Board of Directors, provided they have met the qualifications and vote requirements in accordance with Bylaws of the corporation.

Article VII

The affairs of the Corporation are to be managed by a Chairman, Secretary, Treasurer, and such other officers as the Board of Directors shall elect. The manner of election and term of office shall be provided in the Bylaws.

Article VIII

The Bylaws of the Corporation shall be adopted by the Board of Directors and may be amended or rescinded in accordance with the applicable provisions of the Bylaws.

Article IX

The Corporation shall exist perpetually.

Article X

These Articles of Incorporation may be amended by a majority vote of those present and voting at any meeting of the Board of Directors of the corporation provided that ten (10) days' notice has been given. The amendments shall be filed with, and approved by, the Secretary of State.
