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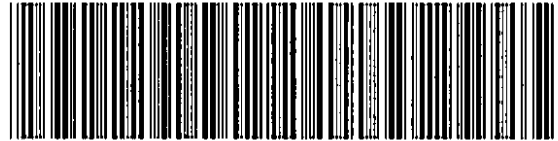

ARTICLE III PURPOSE:

The purpose for which the corporation is organized is:

Florida non-profit Corporation committed to rescue, rehabilitate and adopt homeless felines to their forever home! Trap, Neuter/Spay, Vaccinate, and Release feral cats in an effort to reduce the feline overpopulation in the Florida Panhandle. Educate the community and raise awareness regarding TNR practices and how it works in reducing the feline population. Provide food, water, shelter and medical care as needed to feral feline colonies.

This non-profit corporation is organized exclusively for charitable, literary, and educational purposes including for such purposes the making of distributions to organizations that qualify under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code or any corresponding section, of any future federal tax code. No proceeds of the corporation will enrich any individual, except that reasonable compensation may be paid in exchange for services to the corporation.

No part of the net earnings of the non-profit corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the non-profit corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article Third hereof. No substantial part of the activities of the non-profit corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the non-profit corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the non-profit corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a non-profit corporation exempt from federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or (b) by a non-profit corporation, contributions to which are deductible under section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

Upon the dissolution of the non-profit corporation, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by a Court of Competent Jurisdiction of the county in which the principal office of the non-profit corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.

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
