**ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION**  
**OF**  
**EPIPHANY CITY CHAPTER # 16**  
**AHEPA, INC.**  
**A NONPROFIT CORPORATION**

The undersigned, natural person of the age of eighteen years or older, acting as incorporator for the purpose of creating a nonprofit corporation under the laws of the State of Florida in compliance with Chapter 617, F. S., do hereby set forth:

- Article I. The name of the corporation is Epiphany City Chapter #16. Order of AHEPA, Inc.
- Article II. The principal place of business and mailing address of this corporation is:

- Article III. The purpose for which the corporation is organized are:
- a. Epiphany City Chapter #16 AHEPA, Inc. is organized for exclusively religious, cultural, charitable, educational and scientific purposes within the meaning of Section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding provision of any United States Internal Revenue Law, including, for such purposes, the making to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under said Section of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986. Specifically, the organization will provide education and mentoring programs to the public.
  - b. Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles, this organization shall not carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on by an organization exempt from Federal Income Tax under Section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law.
  - c. No part of the activities of the corporation shall be carrying on propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, or participating in, or intervening in any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office (including the publication or distribution of statements).

- Article VIII. This corporation shall have members duly voted into the Chapter.

- Article IX. No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of any officer or board member of the corporation. And upon the dissolution of the corporation, the board of governors shall, after paying or making provision for payment of all the liabilities of the corporation, dispose of the residual assets of the corporation exclusively for exempt purposes of the corporation in such a manner, or to one or more organizations which themselves are exempt as organizations described in Section 501 and 170 (c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or corresponding Sections of any future Internal Code. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by the Superior Court of the county in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, for such purposes or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.

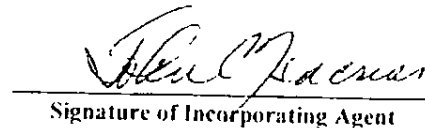
