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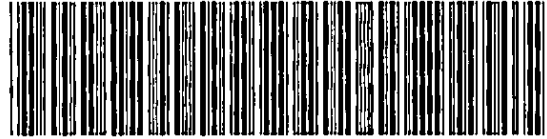

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
HAVING INCREDIBLE VICTORY, INC.

ARTICLE I
CORPORATE NAME

The name of the nonprofit corporation is **HAVING INCREDIBLE VICTORY, INC.**

ARTICLE II
CORPORATE PURPOSES

The purposes for which the Corporation is organized and operated are exclusively for charitable purposes and educational within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law.

The Corporation's charitable and educational goals shall be met primarily by its commitment to aid services throughout the Jacksonville community but not limited to the following:

- (a) **Having Incredible Victory, Inc.** is to host workshops of small groups so that HIV prevention can be discussed in depth.
- (b) **Having Incredible Victory, Inc.** is to provide supportive services to the families with children with HIV such as; caring guidance, education and caregiver tools and resources.
- (c) **Having Incredible Victory, Inc.** is to improve our community acceptance of others who are infected and their families by providing education and awareness
- (d) **Having Incredible Victory, Inc.** is to provide training and support parents to talk to their children about sex
- (e) **Having Incredible Victory, Inc.** is to provide a safe and affordable housing to those living with HIV/AIDS.
- (f) **Having Incredible Victory, Inc.** is to provide Food & Clothes Assistance
- (g) **Having Incredible Victory, Inc.** is to provide transportation to and from doctor's appointments
- (h) **Having Incredible Victory, Inc.** is to receive, maintain, and accept as assets of the corporation property, whether real, personal, or mixed, by way of gift, bequest, devise, or purchase from any person, firm, trust, or corporation, and be held, administered, and disposed of exclusively for charitable, religious, educational, and scientific purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code as amended, and in accordance with and pursuant to the provisions of the Articles of Incorporation. No gift, bequest, devise, or purchase of any such property shall be received and accepted if it is conditional or limited in such manner as shall require the disposition of income or principal to any organization other than a "charitable organization" for any purposes other than the "charitable purposes" which jeopardize the status of the Corporation, an entity exempt from federal income tax pursuant to the relevant provisions of the Internal Revenue Code, as amended; and

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ARTICLE III LIMITATIONS

1. At all times the following shall operate as condition restricting the operation and activities of the corporation not qualifying as exempt under Section 501©(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as now enacted or hereafter amended, nor to any Directors or officers of the corporation, nor to any other private persons, excepting solely such reasonable compensation that the corporation shall pay for services actually rendered to the corporation, or allowed by the corporation as a reasonable allowance for authorized expenditures incurred on the corporation.
2. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall constitute the carrying on of propaganda or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, or any initiative or referendum before the public, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including by publication or distribution of statements), any political campaign on behalf of, or in opposition to, any candidate for public office; and
3. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under Section 501©(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as now enacted or hereafter amended.
4. The corporation shall not lend any of its assets to any officer or director of this corporation (unless such loan program is regularly conducted as part of the activities of the organization and the qualification of the individual to participate in same is determined by a panel comprised solely of non-Board members), or guarantee to any person the payment of a loan by an officer or director of this corporation.

ARTICLE IV DIRECTORS/MEMBERS

The corporation should have no members. The management and affairs of the corporation shall be at all time under the direction of a Board of Directors as define in the corporation bylaws.
