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EXHIBIT "A"

AMENDMENTS TO THE ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF CATALINA AT THE POLO CLUB CONDOMINIUM ASSOCIATION, INC.

The Declaration of Condominium for Catalina at the Polo Club, a Condominium is recorded in Official Records Book 5265, at Page 872, in the Public Records of Palm Beach County, Florida.

As indicated herein, words underlined are added and words struck through are deleted.

Item 1: Article II, Paragraph G of the Articles of Incorporation of the Articles of Incorporation for Catalina at the Polo Club Condominium Association, Inc. ("Articles") shall be amended as follows:

G. The Association shall have all of the common law and statutory powers of a corporation not for profit which are not in conflict with the terms of these Articles, the Declaration of Condominium, the Bylaws and the Condominium Act. The Association shall also have all of the powers of Condominium Associations under and pursuant to Chapter 718, Florida Statutes, the Condominium Act, as same may be amended from time to time, and shall have all of the powers reasonably necessary to implement the purposes of the Association.

Item 2: Article VI, Section B of the Articles shall be amended as follows:

B. The number of Directors to be elected, the manner of their election and their respective terms shall be as set forth in Article III of the Association's Bylaws. Should a vacancy occur on the Board, the remaining Directors shall select a member to fill the vacancy for the balance of the unexpired term remaining, until the next annual meeting of the membership.

The following persons shall constitute the initial Board of Directors and they shall hold office for the term and in accordance with the provisions of Article III—of the Association's Bylaws:

Item 3: Article VII of the Articles shall be amended as follows:

Officers

The affairs of the Association shall be administered by the Officers designated in the Bylaws, who shall serve at the pleasure of said Board of Directors. The names and addresses of the Officers who shall serve until the first election of Officers pursuant to the provisions of the Bylaws are as follows:

Item 4: Article IX, Section B of the Articles shall be amended as follows:

B. A resolution for the adoption of a proposed amendment may be proposed either by the Board of Directors, acting upon the vote of a majority of the Board of Directors, or by the members of the Association having a majority of the votes in the Association. In order for any amendment or amendments to be effective, same must be approved by an affirmative vote of 66 2/3 a majority of the entire Board of Directors and by an affirmative vote of a majority of the members present and voting in person or by proxy at a duly called meeting called for such purpose. the members having 75% of the votes of the Association.

Item 5: Article X of the Articles shall be amended as follows:

INDEMNIFICATION

Every Director, and every Officer and every committee member of the Association shall be indemnified by the Association against all expenses and liabilities, including counsel fees reasonably incurred by or imposed upon the Director or Officer in connection with any proceeding or any settlement thereof to which the Director, or Officer or committee member may be a party, or in which the Director,

Officer or committee member being or having been a Director, Θτ Officer or committee member being or having been a Director, Θτ Officer or committee member of the Association, whether or not a Director, Θτ Officer or committee member at the time such expenses are incurred, except in such cases wherein the Director, Θτ Officer or committee member is adjudged guilty of willful misfeasance or malfeasance or gross negligence in the performance of the Director's, Θτ Officer's or committee member's duty; provided that in the event of a settlement, the indemnification herein shall apply only when the Board of Directors approves such settlement and reimbursement as being for the best interest of the Association. The foregoing right of indemnification shall be in addition to and not exclusive of all of the rights to which such Director, Θτ Officer or committee member may be entitled.
