Under the provisions of F.S. 617.1006, this corporation adopts the following articles  
Of amendment to its articles of incorporation:

FIRST: Amendments Adopted:

The following articles are being added:

Article XVI. Said corporation is organized exclusively for charitable, religious or scientific purposes, within the meaning of section 501(c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code (or corresponding section of any future Federal tax code.)

Article XVII No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, directors, officers or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable Compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of Section 501(c)(3) purposes. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office.


Article XVIII - Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from Federal income tax under Section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code (or corresponding section of any future Federal tax code)

Article XIX - Upon dissolution of this corporation assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, i.e. charitable, educational, religious or scientific, or corresponding section of any future Federal government, or to a state or local government for a public purpose.

SECOND: The articles were adopted on January 17, 2000.

THIRD: Adoption of Amendment (s)

The directors without member action adopted the amendments and member action was not required.
