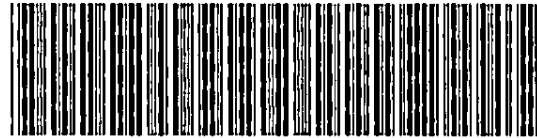

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

In compliance with F.S., Chapter 617 (*Not for Profit*)

PREAMBLE. Wherefore, the undersigned citizens of the United States, desiring to form a not for profit corporation, under the Florida Not for Profit Corporation Act, Chapter 617, Florida Statutes, certify and acknowledge the following:

ARTICLE I

NAME

Name. The name shall be: COOP'S LEGACY FOUNDATION INCORPORATED.

ARTICLE II

PRINCIPAL OFFICE

Office. Having as its governance and having been organized under the laws of the State of Florida, with the Florida Statutes applying to the governance of the Corporation, the initial principal office and mailing address of the not-for-profit corporation is: 2451 MONTE CRISTO WAY, SANFORD, FL 32771.

ARTICLE III

PURPOSE

Corporate Purpose. Established in Memory of Johnny Cooper, this Not-for-Profit Corporation is organized exclusively for the purpose of charitable scholarship and educational purposes, within the meaning of §501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or as may be amended. Such lawful charitable purpose will include athletic scholarship and/or educational outreach programs advocating for Heart Health Awareness. Such lawful charitable purpose may also include any such lawful charitable purpose, permitted under state and/or federal law to include such financial, real estate, grant management, and other such functions necessary to the effective management or operation of the not-for-profit corporation, in furtherance of its charitable mission.

ARTICLE IV

MANNER OF ELECTION


Election. The directors of the Corporation shall be elected in accordance with methods and qualifications specified in the bylaws of the Corporation and shall be in accordance with applicable state/federal law.

ARTICLE V



ARTICLE VIII DISSOLUTION

Dissolution Clause Provisions. Upon the dissolution of this organization, any assets remaining shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes, within the meaning of §501(C)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or under operation of Florida's *cy pres* provision, to a state or local government, for a public purpose.

ARTICLE IX PROHIBITIONS

Prohibitions. In accordance with §501(C)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, the nonprofit will not engage in activities unrelated to its exempt purposes or in prohibited political or legislative activity.
