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ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF MIAMI BLACK HISTORY MUSEUM, INC.

(A Florida Not-For-Profit Corporation)

<u>ARTICLE 1</u>

NAME

The name of the corporation shall be MIAMI BLACK HISTORY MUSEUM, INC. (the "Corporation").

ARTICLE 2

PRINCIPAL OFFICE AND MAILING ADDRESS

The address of the principal office and the mailing address of the Corporation is 1450 Brickell Avenue, 23rd Floor, Miami, Florida 33131.

ARTICLE 3

PURPOSE

The Corporation is a not-for-profit corporation, organized and to be operated exclusively for charitable purposes, within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code o 1986, as amended (the "Code"), and not for pecuniary profit. More specifically, the Corporation is organized and shall be operated exclusively to carry out the following purposes:

- (a) To explore and preserve African American history and culture, and to provide for research, publication and dissemination of information related to the history and development of the African American community; and
- (b) To carry on such other activities in furtherance of the foregoing purposes as are lawful and proper for corporations formed under the Florida Not-for-Profit Corporation Act and exempt from federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Code.

ARTICLE 4

MEMBERSHIP

The Corporation shall have no members.

ARTICLE 5

INITIAL REGISTERED OFFICE AND AGENT

The street address of the initial registered office of the Corporation is 1200 South Pine Island Road, Plantation, Florida 33324, and the name of the Corporation's initial registered ager at that address is C T Corporation System.

ARTICLE 6

INITIAL OFFICERS AND/OR DIRECTORS

The affairs of the Corporation shall be managed by a Board of Directors. The number c directors shall initially be two (2). The number of directors may be increased or decreased from time to time as set forth in the Bylaws of the Corporation, but shall never be less than two (2) The manner of election of members of the Board of Directors shall be as set forth in the Bylaw of the Corporation. ARTICLE 8

DISSOLUTION

Upon the dissolution of the Corporation, its assets remaining after payment, or provision for payment, of all debts and liabilities of the Corporation, shall be distributed to a not-for-profi fund, foundation or corporation which is organized and operated exclusively for charitable purposes and which has established its tax-exempt status under section 501(c)(3) of the Code (o the corresponding provision of any future federal tax laws), as selected by the Board of Directors.

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ARTICLE 9

LIMITATIONS

No part of the net earnings of the Corporation shall inure to the benefit of its director officers or other private persons, except that the Corporation shall be authorized to pa reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments in furtherance of any of it charitable purposes. No part of the activities of the Corporation shall be the carrying on c propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation (except as otherwise provided i subsection (h) of section 501 of the Code), and the Corporation shall not participate or interven in any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding an other provision of these Articles, the Corporation shall not carry on any activities not permitte to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Code (or the corresponding provision of any future federal tax laws), or (b) by a corporation contributions to which are deductible under section 170(c)(2) of the Code (or the corresponding provision of any future federal tax laws).
