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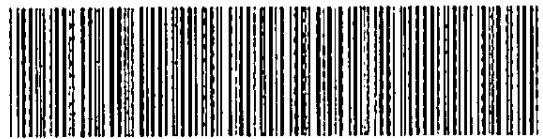

AMENDED ARTICLES

Article III

Section A.

The purpose of the organization is to empower entertainment and education by promoting Haitian African Art and culture through media and social media show, cultural events, and talent contests. As well as transact any and all lawful business for which corporations may be incorporated under the Florida Not-For-Profit Corporation Act.

The corporation is organized exclusively for charitable, religious, educational, and specific and general purposes that qualify as exempt organizations under Section 501(C)3 of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

Section B.

No part of the net earnings of the organization shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its directors, trustees, officers, or any other private individual (except that the organization shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purpose set forth in the purpose clause hereof). No substantial part of the activities of the organization shall be the

carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the organization shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office.

Notwithstanding any other provision of this document, the organization shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by an organization exempt from federal income tax under section of any future federal tax code, or

(b) by an organizations' contributions to which are deductible under section 170(c)2 of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

Section C

Upon the dissolution of the organization, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(C)3 of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state and local government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose.

Any such assets not disposed of shall be disposed of by the Court of Common Pleas of the county in which the principal office of the organization is then located, exclusively for such purposed or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.

Article IV

Upon election of the first Board of Directors by the President, such Board of Directors manages the business affairs of this corporation without the necessity of other authority. Any action of

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such Board of Directors may be rescinded, or any officer or director removed from office, only upon a vote of the majority from the Board of Directors.
