ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
FLORIDA IMMIGRANT PAC, INC.

The undersigned subscribes to these Articles of Incorporation for the purpose of forming a corporation not-for-profit pursuant to the provisions of the Florida Not for Profit Corporation Act, Chapter 617, Florida Statutes.

ARTICLE I
Name, Street Address and Mailing Address

The name of the corporation shall be "Florida Immigrant PAC, Inc." The principal street and mailing address of the corporation is: 2800 Biscayne Boulevard, Suite 200, Miami, Florida 33137.

ARTICLE II
Duration

This corporation shall have perpetual existence.

ARTICLE III
Purpose

The primary purpose for which this corporation is created and maintained shall be to conduct political activities as a "political organization," including the support of and opposition to candidates for office in Florida, and to conduct one or more activities permitted under Section 527 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, and the Florida Election Code.

ARTICLE VII
Officers

This corporation may select the following officers to govern its day to day affairs: President/Chair and Treasurer. The bylaws may provide for additional officers. The incorporator shall appoint the initial officers.

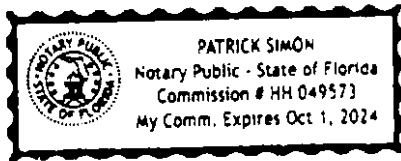
An individual may hold more than one office in the corporation. Duties of Officers shall be described in the by-laws.
