Articles of Incorporation

of

In accordance with Chapter 617.0202, Florida Statutes, the undersigned Incorporator hereby files these Articles of Incorporation to form a not-for-profit corporation under the laws of the State of Florida.

ARTICLE I Name

The name of the corporation shall be: MIAMI BEACH LIFESAFETY INSTITUTE EMS & FIRE ORGANIZATION, INC.

ARTICLE III Purpose

A. <u>GENERAL</u>. The corporation is organized exclusively for charitable and educational purposes. The corporation shall provide education and information to members of the public as may be appropriate by means of training, education, mentorship, necessary to prepare youths for a career in the fire service in accordance with the Florida Fire Chief Association Cadet Program, including but not limited to fire rescue, emergency medical services, ocean rescue, and fire prevention. The corporation shall support prevention programs for at risk youth, including such programs as the Youth Fire Setters Intervention Program, as developed with the standards established by the National Fire Academy, Emmitsburg, MD. In addition, the corporation will offer educational certification programs to promote lifesaving and fire safety for the community and the professional members of the fire service; and to do any and all lawful activities which may be necessary, useful, or desirable to pursue the foregoing.

B. <u>501(c)(3) LIMITATION</u>. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted (i) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or (ii) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

ARTICLE IV Manner of Election

ARTICLE VI Nonprofit Organization

The following will apply to said corporation:

- A. <u>NO PRIVATE INUREMENT</u>. No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its Officers, Directors or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article III.
- B. <u>LOBBYING AND POLITICAL CAMPAIGNS</u>. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office.
- DISSOLUTION. Upon the dissolution of the corporation, assets remaining after payment of all debts and liabilities shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal, state or local government for a public purpose. The organization to receive the assets of the corporation hereunder shall be selected by the Board of Directors pursuant to the corporation's bylaws. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by a court of competent jurisdiction of the county in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.
