ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION Of THE OAK HILL GARDEN CLUB FOUNDATION, INC. A NONPROFIT CORPORATION

The undersigned, natural person of the age of eighteen years or older, acting as incorporator for the purpose of creating a nonprofit corporation under the laws of the State of Florida in compliance with Chapter 617, F.S., do hereby set forth:

Article I The name of the corporation is **The Oak Hill Garden Club Foundation, Inc.**

The purposes for which the corporation is organized are:

- a. The Oak Hill Garden Club Foundation, Inc. is organized for exclusively religious, charitable, educational and scientific purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under said Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986. Specifically, the organization will provide education to the community as well as charitable giving and benevolent assistance for those in need.
