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ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

VOA FREEDOM POINTE AH GP, INC. (a Florida Not-For-Profit Corporation)

Pursuant to the provisions of Section 617.0202 of the Florida Not for Profit Corporation Act, the undersigned does hereby execute and submit for filing with the Florida Department of State these Articles of Incorporation as follows:

ARTICLE I

NAME

The name of this corporation is VOA Freedom Pointe AH GP, Inc. (the "Corporation").

ARTICLE II

PRINCIPAL OFFICE AND MAILING ADDRESS

The address of the principal office and the mailing address of the Corporation is 1660 Duke Street, Alexandria, VA 22314.

ARTICLE III

<u>PURPOSE</u>

The Corporation is not formed for pecuniary profit or financial gain. The Corporation shall be a not for profit corporation under the Florida Not for Profit Corporation Act and is irrevocably dedicated to and operated exclusively for non-profit purposes. The purposes for which the Corporation is organized are exclusively charitable within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended (or any successor thereto) including but not limited to, the fostering of low income housing to low and moderate income families. The Corporation, in connection with furthering its purposes, shall be permitted to engage (either directly or through ownership of interests) in the acquisition, construction, management, and leasing of the apartments in such buildings to tenants who qualify consistent with, and recognized as charitable by, the Internal Revenue Service in Revenue Procedure 96-32. Consistent with the foregoing, the Corporation shall additionally be permitted to develop, acquire, construct, manage, operate, lease and sell mobile homes, modular housing, manufactured housing and/or mobile home parks. Furthermore, this corporation may engage only in activities permitted under the laws of the State of Florida and the United States of America as shall constitute activities in furtherance of such exempt purposes. In furtherance of its exempt purposes, the corporation may promote establish, conduct and maintain activities on its own behalf and it may contribute to or otherwise assist other

corporations, organizations and institutions carrying on exempt activities. No substantial part of the activities of the Corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation. The Corporation shall not participate in or intervene in (including the publishing or distributing of statements), any political campaign on behalf of (or in opposition to) any candidate for public office.

ARTICLE IV

<u>POWERS</u>

The corporation hereby incorporates by reference any and all corporate powers given to corporations not for profit by virtue of Section 617.0302 of the Florida Statutes. The corporation's activities are limited by any and all restrictions that are required to obtain tax exempt status under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended (or any successor thereto). No substantial part of the assets or the net carnings of the Corporation shall inure to the benefit of, nor be distributed to, any officer or director of the Corporation, or to any other private person, in such a fashion as to constitute an application of funds not within the purpose of a charitable organizations described in Code Section 501(c)(3). However, reimbursement for expenditures or the payment of reasonable compensation for services rendered to the Corporation shall not be deemed to be a distribution of earnings or assets.

ARTICLE V

NO MEMBERS

The Corporation will not have members.

ARTICLE VI

ARTICLE VII

BOARD OF DIRECTORS; OFFICERS

The business affairs of the Corporation shall be managed and all the corporate powers thereof shall be vested in and exercised by a Board of Directors. The Board of Directors shall be appointed as provided in the bylaws of the Corporation, which the Board of Directors shall adopt. The initial Board of Directors shall consist of three (3) persons.
