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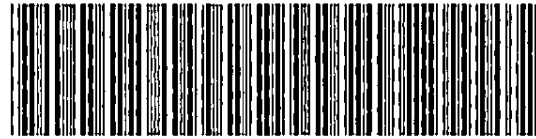

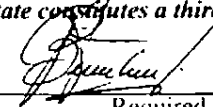

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

In compliance with Chapter 617, F.S., (Not for Profit)

Article IX: Upon dissolution of the Corporation, the Board of Directors, after paying or making provisions for the payment of all of the liabilities of the Corporation out of the assets thereof, will distribute all residual assets of the Corporation to organizations organized and operated exclusively for charitable, educational, religious or scientific purposes which, at the time of such disposition, qualify as exempt organizations under Section 501(c)(4) of the Code or the corresponding provision of any future law of the United States of America. Any assets not so distributed will be disposed of by a court of competent jurisdiction exclusively for such charitable purposes, or to such organization or organizations organized and operated exclusively for such charitable purposes, as said court determines.

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
