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# ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

#### ARTICLE I

The name of the nonprofit corporation is **Helping Hands Caretaker, INC.**

#### ARTICLE II

##### CORPORATE PURPOSES

The purposes for which the Corporation is organized and operated are exclusively for charitable purposes and educational within the meaning of Section 501©(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law.

The Corporation's charitable and educational goals shall be met primarily by its commitment to aid services throughout the Miami community but not limited to the following:

**MISSION:** Helping Hands Caretakers is a community services initiative that's mission is to give back to those in need through the Acts of Kindness.

**VISION:** Through 5 Acts of Kindness, HHC will provide Hope, Empowerment and Support to the elderly, disabled, single mothers, & veterans.

- a) Free Lawn Care Service: As an Act of kindness we will provide free lawn care services to our elders, disabled, single mothers and our veterans, who are unable to complete the physical activity necessary to keep their yard or there is a lack of resources and/or money.
- b) Here at HHC, we want everyone to have a safe, clean and beautiful yard to enjoy and to be proud of.
- c) Volunteer Service: As an Act of Kindness we will host and train volunteers from across generations to work together to help those in needs while strengthening community bonds.
- d) Youth in Action: As an Act of Kindness we host weekend volunteering and mentoring to youth with the goal is to empower young people the importance of giving back while keeping our community clean, vibrant, and beautiful!
- e) Our mission is to educate and inspire our young people to take action.
- f) Give-A-Way: As an Act of Kindness we will host a community supplies give-a-way to those in need of school supplies, toiletries, household cleaning supplies, food, gas cards, and bus tokens and or cards

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- g) Annual Community Cleanup Day: As an Act of Kindness we will host an annual Community Cleanup Day that will bring volunteers together to clean, repair, and improve public spaces or other areas (such as vacant lots or abandoned properties) that have been neglected, vandalized, or misused. Cleanup projects can involve all kinds of public spaces—parks, riverbanks, schoolyards, sidewalks, playing fields, and even parking lots, to name just a few.

### ARTICLE III LIMITATIONS

1. At all times the following shall operate as condition restricting the operation and activities of the corporation not qualifying as exempt under Section 501©(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as now enacted or hereafter amended, nor to any Directors or officers of the corporation, nor to any other private persons, excepting solely such reasonable compensation that the corporation shall pay for services actually rendered to the corporation, or allowed by the corporation as a reasonable allowance for authorized expenditures incurred on the corporation.
2. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall constitute the carrying on of propaganda or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, or any initiative or referendum before the public, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including by publication or distribution of statements), any political campaign on behalf of, or in opposition to, any candidate for public office; and
3. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under Section 501©(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as now enacted or hereafter amended.
4. The corporation shall not lend any of its assets to any officer or director of this corporation (unless such loan program is regularly conducted as part of the activities of the organization and the qualification of the individual to participate in same is determined by a panel comprised solely of non-Board members), or guarantee to any person the payment of a loan by an officer or director of this corporation.

### ARTICLE IV DIRECTORS/MEMBERS

The corporation should have no members. The management and affairs of the corporation shall be at all times under the direction of a Board of Directors as define in the corporation bylaws.

MANAGEMENT OF CORPORATE AFFAIRS

The powers of the Corporation shall be exercised by or under the authority of, and the business and affairs of the Corporation shall manage under the direction of, a Board of Directors which shall have four (4) directors initially. The number of directors may be increased or decreased from time to time by a majority of the directors, but at no times shall there be fewer than four (4) directors of the Corporation.

ARTICLE VIII  
INITIAL DIRECTORS

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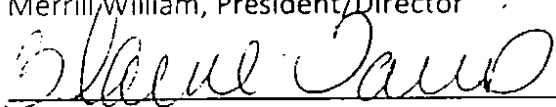
ARTICLE XIII  
MISCELLANEOUS

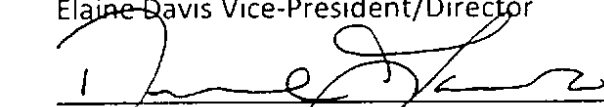

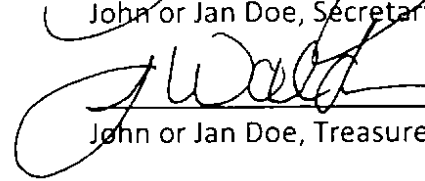

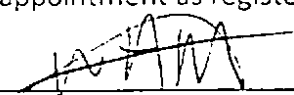
