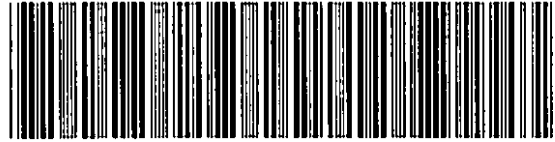

Washington Park Bison Association, Inc.

Purpose Clause

Washington Park Bison Association is organized exclusively for charitable and educational purposes, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future tax code. No part of the net earnings of Washington Park Bison Association shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its board, officers, or other private persons, except that the association authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payment and distributions in furtherance of the purpose set forth in the purpose clause hereof.

Notwithstanding any other provision of this document, the association shall not carry on (a) by any organization exempt from federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or (b) by an organization, contributions to which are deductible under section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

The specific purposes of the Washington Park Bison Association are to focus on, Litter Prevention, Beautification, Community Improvement and Waste Reduction

1) Litter Prevention

- a) The association shall promote and organize community alliances to advance and imitate litter prevention and cleanup efforts.
- b) The association shall develop partnership to conduct community outreach for anti-litter and proper waste handling educational campaigns.

2) Beautification and Community Improvement

The association shall develop public-private partnership for improving the visual aspects of our Community through programs that beautify and clean the environment such as Community gardens, native and wildflowers planting and streets and road beautification.

3) Waste Reduction

The association shall undertake effort to reduce the impact of solid waste on our Community through public education and outreach effort for source reduction, reuse, recycling and composting.

Washington Park Bison Association, Inc. Dissolution Clause

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TALLAHASSEE, FL

Upon termination or dissolution of the Washington Park Bison Association, any assets lawfully available for distribution shall be distributed to one (1) or more qualifying organizations described in Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or described in any corresponding provision of any successor statute) which organization or organizations have a charitable purpose which, at least generally, includes a purpose similar to the terminating or dissolving corporation.

The organization to receive the assets of the Washington Park Bison Association hereunder shall be selected by the discretion of a majority of the managing body of the association and if its members cannot agree, then the recipient organization shall be selected pursuant to a verified petition in equity filed in a court of proper jurisdiction against the Washington Park Bison Association by one (1)

or more of its managing body which verified petition shall contain such statements as reasonably indicate the applicable shall select the qualifying organization or organizations to receive the assets to be distributed, giving preference if practicable to organizations located within the state of Florida

In the event that the court shall find that this section is applicable but that there is no qualifying organization known to it which has a charitable purpose which, at least generally, includes a purpose similar to this association, then the court shall direct the distribution to the Treasurer of the State of Florida to be added to the general funds.
