

## **Attachment to Articles of Incorporation of The Power of Music, Inc.**

Said organization is organized exclusively for charitable, religious, educational, and scientific purposes, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under the section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code. The business activity for said organization is as follows: **To inspire hope and contribute to health and well-being by providing the best care to every patient.**

**Listening to music is a non-pharmacological intervention that can be utilized to help patients manage symptoms associated with being mechanically ventilated. Researchers have explored and investigated the use of a music listening intervention with mechanically ventilated (MV) patients as means of managing pain, discomfort, and anxiety. Researchers have found that MV patients who listened to 30 minutes of preferred music demonstrated a significant decrease in state anxiety.<sup>5, 6</sup> Some research has shown that listening to music significantly decreases physiological measures associated with anxiety such as, heart rate, systolic and diastolic blood pressure, and respiratory rates.**

**This review of the research included eight randomized and quasi-randomized controlled trials, which included a total of 213 patients. They reported that the findings of these studies suggest that a music listening intervention is a viable intervention for managing stress and anxiety and may positively impact heart rate, respiratory rate, and anxiety in MV patients.**

**Incorporating music into the care of the ventilated patient has strong potential to alleviate the symptom burden and the high cost of conventional treatments as well as increase patient satisfaction and promote efficient weaning.**
