Articles of Incorporation of

The Power of Music, Inc.

Said organization is organized exclusively for charitable, religious, educational, and scientific purposes, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under the section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code. The business activity for said organization is as follows: To inspire hope and contribute to health and well-being by providing the best care to every patient.

Listening to music is a non-pharmacological intervention that can be utilized to help patients manage symptoms associated with being mechanically ventilated. Researchers have explored and investigated the use of a music listening intervention with mechanically ventilated (MV) patients as means of managing pain, discomfort, and anxiety. Researchers have found that MV patients who listened to 30 minutes of preferred music demonstrated a significant decrease in state anxiety.5, 6 Some research has shown that listening to music significantly decreases physiological measures associated with anxiety such as, heart rate, systolic and diastolic blood pressure, and respiratory rates.

This review of the research included eight randomized and quasi-randomized controlled trials, which included a total of 213 patients. They reported that the findings of these studies suggest that a music listening intervention is a viable intervention for managing stress and anxiety and may positively impact heart rate, respiratory rate, and anxiety in MV patients.

Incorporating music into the care of the ventilated patient has strong potential to alleviate the symptom burden and the high cost of conventional treatments as well as increase patient satisfaction and promote efficient weaning.

No part of the net earnings of this organization shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to, its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth herein. Notwithstanding any other provision of this document, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under section 501(c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under section 170(c) (2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

Upon the dissolution of this corporation, assets remaining shall be distributed for one

or more exempt purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed by a Court of Competent Jurisdiction of the county in which the principal office of the organization is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.
