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

#### **ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION**

#### Hannah's Hope House, Inc.

#### **ARTICLE I**

The name of the nonprofit corporation is Hannah's Hope House, Inc.

#### ARTICLE II CORPORATE PURPOSES

The purposes for which the Corporation is organized and operated are exclusively for charitable purposes educational within the meaning of Section 501©(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, c corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law.

The Corporation's charitable and educational goals shall be met primarily by its commitment to aid services throughout the Jacksonville community but not limited to the following:

Hannah's Hope House vision is to transform the lives of children and their families experiencing homeles through comprehensive street outreach that restores dignity and provide assistance to families to reach housing and life goals.

Hannah's Hope House mission is to partners alongside with our City in making the experience of homeles rare, brief and non-recurring through Prevention, Assistance & Restoration.

- (a) Hannah's Hope House, Inc. will provide essential care package to families that are in need
- (b) Hannah's Hope House, Inc. will host food and clothes give-a-ways to those in need
- (c) Hannah's Hope House, Inc. will help decrease the numbers of families becoming homeless through collaboration and partnership
- (d) Hannah's Hope House, Inc. will help provide skills training to individuals to obtain gainful employments
- (e) Hannah's Hope House, Inc. will bridge the gap in services and resources to individuals returning to from being incarcerated
- (f) Hannah's Hope House, Inc. will host job fairs



#### ARTICLE III LIMITATIONS

- No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall constitute the carrying on of propaganc otherwise attempting to influence legislation, or any initiative or referendum before the public, and corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including by publication or distribution of stateme any political campaign on behalf of, or in opposition to, any candidate for public office; and
- 2. Notwithstanding any other provisions of these Bylaws, this corporation shall not carry on any activitie permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under Section 501/ of the Internal Revenue Code, or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under Se 170(c)(2) of Internal Revenue Code.
- 3. The corporation shall not lend any of its assets to any officer or director of this corporation (unless loan program is regularly conducted as part of the activities of the organization and the qualification the individual to participate in same is determined by a panel comprised solely of non-Board mem or guarantee to any person the payment of a loan by an officer or director of this corporation.

# ARTICLE IV DIRECTORS/MEMBERS

The corporation should have no members. The management and affairs of the corporation shall be at all under the direction of a Board of Directors as define in the corporation bylaws.


