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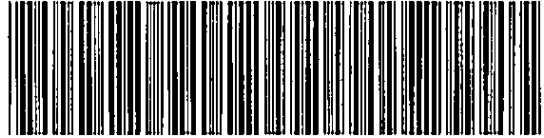



ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

ARTICLE I NAME

1.01 Name

The name of this corporation shall be Empowered Parents Inc. The business of the corporation may be conducted as Empowered Parents Inc..

ARTICLE II DURATION

2.01 Duration

The period of duration of the corporation is perpetual.

ARTICLE III PURPOSE

3.01 Purpose

Empowered Parents Inc. is a non-profit corporation and shall operate exclusively for educational and charitable purposes within the meaning of section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future Federal tax code. Empowered Parents Inc. purpose is to to teach fathers and parents in the community, the necessary skills to be successful, Empowered Parents Inc. and to connect holistically with their children, through specialized experiential learning and psychoeducation. Our program consists of weekend psychoeducation retreats for parents looking to better their relationship with their children and families at no charge to the participants. Our programs include free programming such as group sessions, lectures and experiential learning exercises for participants to maximize learning opportunities. To maximize our impact on current efforts, we may seek to collaborate with other non-profit organizations which fall under the 501(c) (3) section of the internal revenue code and are operated exclusively for educational and charitable purposes. At times, per the description of the board of directors, we may provide internships or volunteer opportunities in order to have a greater impact for change.

3.02 Public Benefit

Empowered Parents Inc. is designates as a public benefit corporation

ARTICLE IV

NON-PROFIT NATURE

4.01 Non-profit Nature

Empowered Parents Inc. is organized exclusively for charitable and educational purposes including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code. No part of the net earning of Empowered Parents Inc. shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in the purpose clause hereof.

Notwithstanding any other provisions of this document, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by any organization exempt from federal income tax under section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code, corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or (b) by an organization, contributions to which are deductible under section 170 (c) (2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

Empowered Parents Inc. is not organized and shall be operated for the private gain of any person. The property of the corporation is irrevocably dedicated to its educational and charitable purposes. No part of the assets, receipts, or net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributed to any individual. The corporation may, however, pay reasonable compensation for services rendered, and make other payments and distributions consistent with these Articles.

4.02 Personal Liability

No officer or director of the corporation shall be personally liable for the debts or obligations of Empowered Parents Inc. of any nature whatsoever, nor shall any of the property or assets of the officers or directors be subject to the payment of the debts or obligations of this corporation.

4.03 Dissolution

Upon termination or dissolution of the Empowered Parents Inc., any assets Lawfully available for distribution shall be distributed to one (1) or more qualifying organizations described in Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue code of 1986 (or described in any corresponding provision of any successor statute) which organization or organizations have charitable purpose which, at least generally, includes a purpose similar to the terminating or dissolving corporation.

The organization to receive the assets of the Empowered Parents Inc. hereunder shall be selected by discretion of a majority of the managing body of Empowered Parents Inc. and if its members cannot so agree, then the recipient organization shall be selected pursuant to a verified petition in equity filed in a court of proper jurisdiction against Empowered Parents Inc. by one (1) or more of its managing body which verified petition shall contain such statements as reasonably indicate the applicability of this section. The court upon a finding that this section is applicable shall select the qualifying organization or organizations to receive the assets to be distributed giving preference if practicable to organizations located within the State of Florida.

In the event that the court shall find that this sections in applicable but that there is no qualifying organization known to it which has charitable purposes, which, at least generally, includes a purpose similar to this corporation, then the court shall direct the distribution of its assets lawfully available for distribution to the Treasurer of the State of Florida to be added to the general fund.

4.03 Prohibited Distributions

No part of the net earnings, or properties of this corporation, on dissolution or otherwise, shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to, its members, directors, officers or other private person or individual, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article III Section 3.01.

4.04 Restricted Activities

No substantial part of the corporation's activities shall be carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene (including the publishing or distribution of statements) in any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office

4.05 Prohibited Activities

Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on (I) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax as an organization described by Section 501(c)(3) of the internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or (II) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170(c)(2) of the internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.
