ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF Better Alternatives, Inc. A FLORIDA NONPROFIT CORPORATION

In Compliance with Chapter 617, F.S., (Not for Profit)

ARTICLE I NAME

The name of the corporation shall be: Better Alternatives, Inc.

ARTICLE II PRINCIPAL OFFICE
