WE. The Undersigned, desirous of forming a not-for profit Corporation under the laws of the State of Florida, having associated ourselves together for such purpose, submits the following Articles of Corporation:

ARTICLE I - NAME

The name of this Corporation shall be.

TEACHING SENIORS' TECH INC.

ARTICLE II - TERM

This Corporation shall have perpetual existence unless dissolved sooner by operation of Law

ARTICLE III - PRINCIPAL OFFICE

The principal place of business for the Corporation:

ARTICLE IV - PURPOSES

Section 1. Our goal is to teach the elderly community how to use technology in an effective way. Section 4. Upon dissolution of the Corporation, the Board of Directors shall, after paying or making provisions for the payment of all the liabilities of the Corporation. No person, firm, or corporation shall ever receive any dividends or profit from the undertakings of this corporation; and upon dissolution of this corporation, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purpose within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the Federal.
