

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF CHILDREN'S RARE CARE RESOURCES, INC.

The purpose for which the corporation is organized is as follows:

Children's Rare Care Resources, Inc.'s mission is to improve the quality of life for children, and their families, suffering from rare and chronic diseases. Children's Rare Care Resources, Inc. will do this by providing a voice for this population through strong advocacy, dissemination of important information, resource allocation, advancing research and innovation, offering support groups, funding of crucial under-provided services, and/or policy advancement through an integrated and comprehensive approach to rare and chronic disease. Children's Rare Care Resources, Inc. will also work to identify other ways in which it may assist this population within the spirit of the charitable, not-for-profit guidelines.

Said corporation is organized exclusively for charitable, religious, educational, and scientific purposes, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

ARTICLE VI

No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article III hereof. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.
