ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION PLEASANT GROVE MINISTRIES OF FLORIDA, INC.

In Compliance with Chapter F.S.. (Not for Profit)

Article I NAME

The name of the Corporation shall be: PLEASANT GROVE MINISTRIES OF FLORIDA, INC.

ARTICLE II PRICIPAL OFFICE

ARTICLE III PURPOSE

The purpose which the corporation is organized is:

The general character and nature of the business to be transacted by this corporation is as follows:

1) As a faith based organization exclusively for charitable, religious, and educational purposes within the meaning of Section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Revenue Law), including, but not limited to, for such purposes as the establishing and maintaining of religious worship, the building, maintaining and operating of churches, faith based ministries, parsonages, schools, chapels, radio programs, television programs, rescue missions, print shops, day care centers, camps, housing, nursing homes, and cemeteries, and any other ministries that the Church may be led of God to establish.

2) To acquire by purchase, lease or otherwise, lands and interest in lands, and to own, hold, improve, develop and manage any real estate so acquired, and to erect, or cause to be erected, on any lands owned, held or occupied, and to encumber or dispose of any lands or interest in lands, and any building or other structures, at any time owned or held by the corporation. To buy, sell, mortgage, exchange, lease hold for investment or otherwise, use and operate, real estate of all kinds improved or unimproved, or any right or interest therein.

3) To acquire, by purchase, lease, manufacture otherwise, any personal property deemed necessary or useful in the equipment, furnishing, improvement, development or management of any property, real or personal, at any time owned, held or occupies by the corporation, and to invest, trade, lease, rent, encumber or dispose of any personal property at any time owned or held by the corporation.

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4) To contract debts and borrow money, issue and sell or pledge bonds, debentures, notes and other evidence of indebtedness, and to execute such mortgages, transfer or corporate property, or other instruments to secure payment of corporate indebtedness as required.

5) To purchase the corporate assets of any other corporation and engage in the same or other character of business.

6) To become a partner with any person or persons, corporation, or any other business entity and engage in the same or other character of business.

7) To guarantee, endorse, purchase, hold, sell, transfer, mortgage, pledge or otherwise acquire or dispose of the shares of capital stock of, or any bonds, securities, or other evidences of indebtedness created by any other corporation of the State of Florida or any other state or government, and while owner of such stock to exercise all the rights, powers and privileges of ownership, including the right to vote such stock.

8) To enter into, make, perform and carry out contract and agreements of every kind, for any lawful purpose, without limit as to amount of any firm, association or corporation, or calculated to facilitate the same.

9) To carry on any or all operations and business, and to promote its objective within the State of Florida or elsewhere without restriction as to place or amount; and to have, use, exercise and enjoy all of the general powers of like corporations.

10) To do any or all these things herein set forth to the same extent as natural persons might or could do, and in any part to the world as principals, agents, contractors or otherwise, alone or in company with others, and to do and perform all such things and act as may be necessary, profitable or expedient in carrying on any of the business or acts above named.

The intention that none of the objects and powers as hereinabove set forth, except where otherwise specified in the Article, shall be in anyway limited or restricted by references to or inference from the terms of any other objects powers, or clauses of this Article or any other Articles; but that the objects and powers specified in each of the clauses of this Article shall be regarded as independent objects and powers.

ARTICLE IV ELECTION OF DIRECTORS

The Corporation shall have five (5) Directors initially. The number of Directors may be increased or diminished from time to time by the By-Laws, but shall never be less than three (3). Officers shall be elected by the membership at its annual business meeting.
