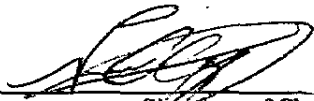

The corporation is organized exclusively for charitable, educational, religious, or scientific purposes within the meaning of section 501(c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code.

SECOND: If an amendment provides for an exchange , reclassification or cancellation of issued shares, provisions for implanting the amendment if not contained in the amendment itself, are as follows: please amend Article VI:

Upon the dissolution of the corporation, the Board of Trustee shall, after paying or making provisions for the payment of all the liabilities of the corporation, dispose of all the assets of the corporation exclusively for the purposes of the corporation .In such manner, or to such organization or organizations organized and operated exclusively for charitable, educational, religious , or scientific purposes as shall at the qualify as an exempt organization or organizations under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Services Law), as the Board of Trustees shall determine. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by the Court OF Common Pleas of the county in which the principal officer of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization organizations , as said court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.
